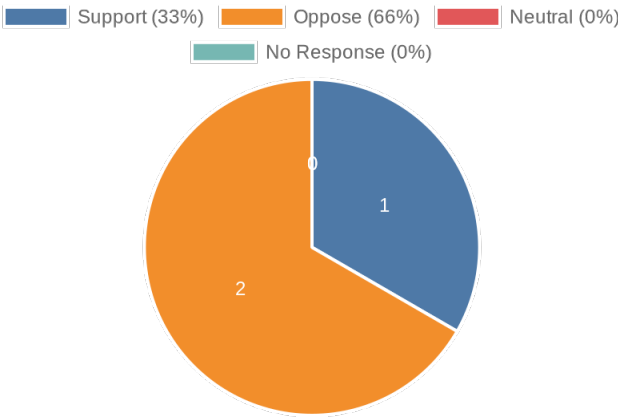

#### Overall Sentiment

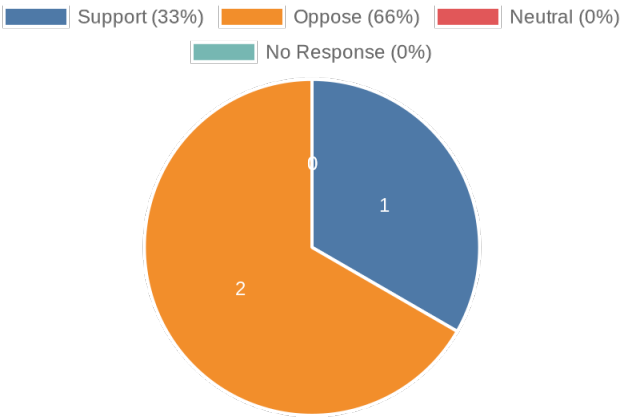

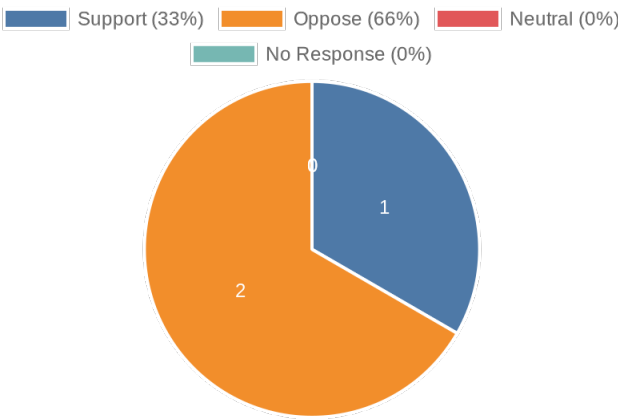
