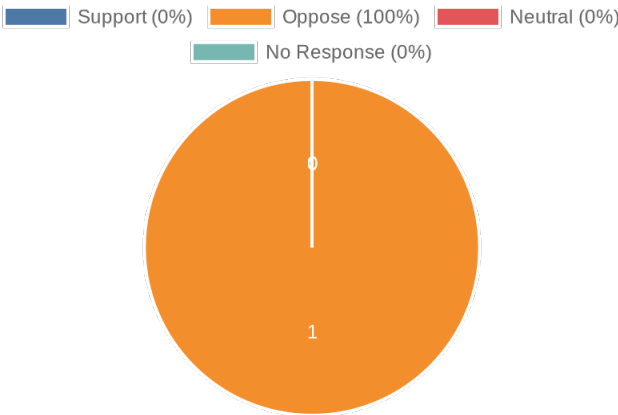

Overall Sentiment

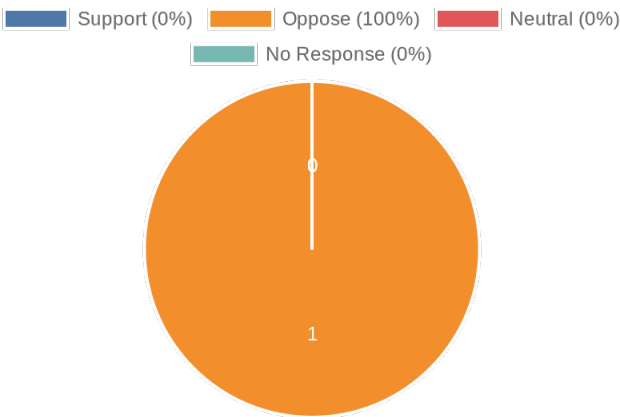

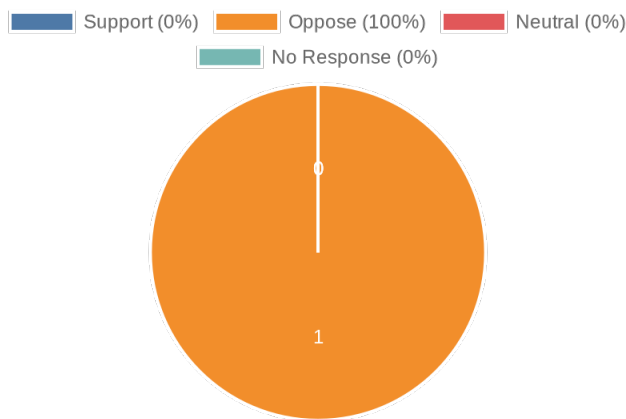
