A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO RELATING TO THE  
WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE FRAUD PROGRAM

WHEREAS the San Diego County District Attorney desires to implement a certain project designated the Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Program to be funded in part from funds made available through California Insurance Code Section 1872.83, and California Code of Regulations Subchapter 9, Article 3, Sections 2698.53, 2698.54, and 2698.57, and administered by the State of California, Department of Insurance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Diego County District Attorney is authorized to administer the Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Program on behalf of the County of San Diego for the period of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, and in subsequent years provided there are no material changes to the agreement terms or funding level.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Administrative Officer, or her designee, and the District Attorney, or her designee, are authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors all grant award documents, including any extensions and amendments thereof, that do not materially impact or alter either the grant program or funding level.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the California Department of Insurance disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
