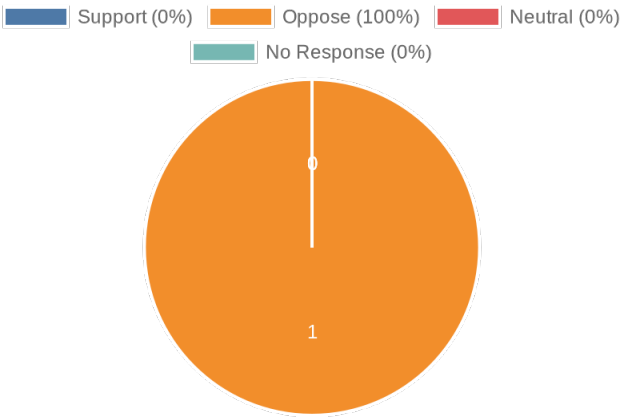

Overall Sentiment

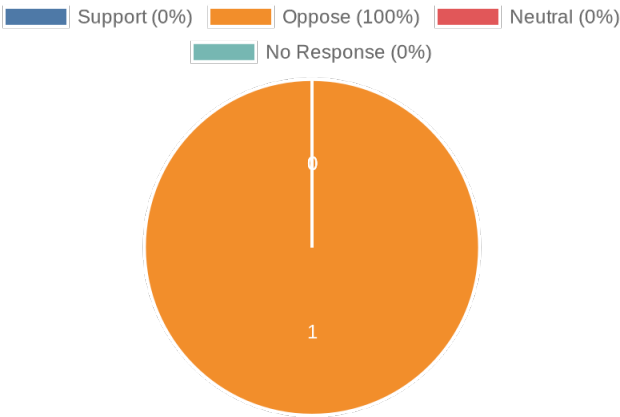

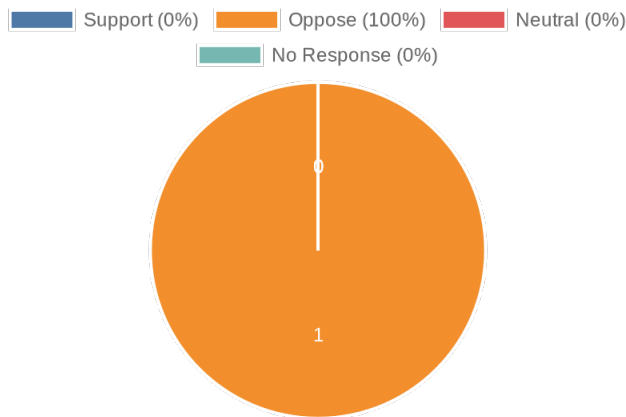

Licenses for institutions with more safety issues than there should be.

Bathhouses in San Diego County are regulated by the San Diego County Department of Environmental Health and Quality (DEHQ) through its Food and Housing Division.

On the other hand, massage parlors in San Diego County are regulated by a combination of local law enforcement, and the state-level California Massage Therapy Council (CAMTC.) And I don't know who in the County regulates holistic health practitioners.

It sounds like the County does not have a very good control on these, but it should. There needs to be some kind of County licensing or control, not State, for each of the institutions. Keep it local! We should not rely on outside help enforcing the law when the State has a huge deficit.
