Dear Members of the San Diego County Board of Supervisors,

I am a San Diego County resident writing to oppose the proposal to increase supervisor term limits from two terms to three terms.

In 2010, county voters approved term limits for supervisors. Regardless of whether individual supervisors believe longer service would be beneficial, voters already expressed their preference for limiting the concentration of political power and ensuring regular opportunities for new representation.

Changing the rules to allow elected officials to remain in office 50% longer raises concerns about accountability and public trust. If voters wish to revisit the issue, they should be presented with a clear, standalone measure focused solely on term limits rather than having the issue bundled with unrelated governance reforms.

I urge the Board to respect the intent of the 2010 vote and reject any effort to weaken those limits.

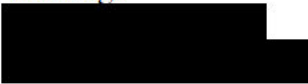
