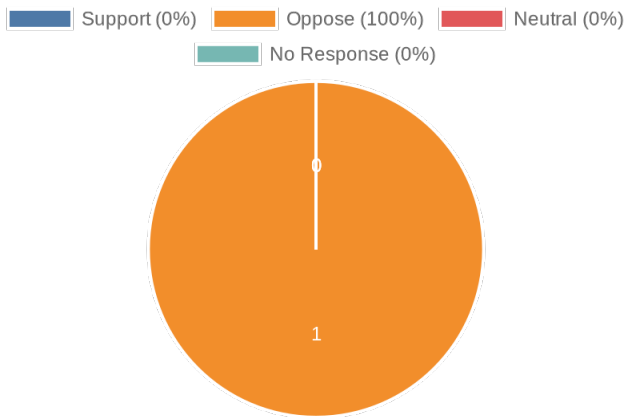

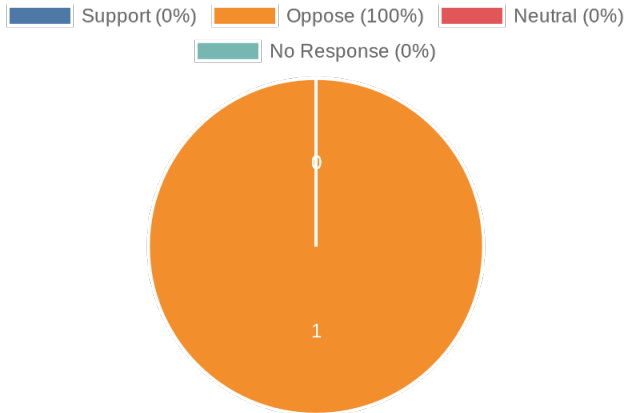

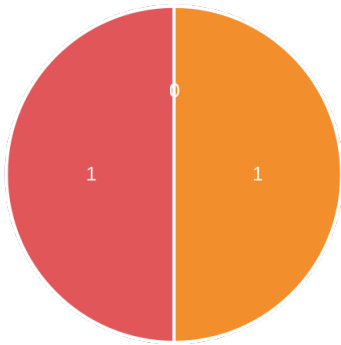

### Overall Sentiment

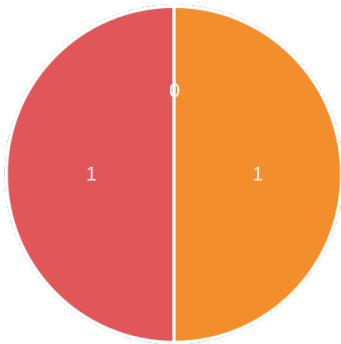
