NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on November 4, 2025 and November 18, 2025 the Board of Supervisors will introduce and consider for adoption an ordinance to amend the San Diego County Regulatory Code. The title of the ordinances and summaries of their changes are provided below:

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY REGULATORY CODE RELATING TO THE RETITLING OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, DEFINING THE DUTIES AND AUTHORITIES OF THE POSITIONS OF DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND QUALITY AND DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, AND RELATED ACTIONS

These amendments will update sections of the Code to align with prior board action, updates to language for clarity and removal of outdated sections. None of the updates will result in changes to current operations.


