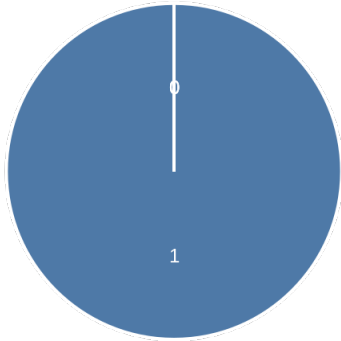

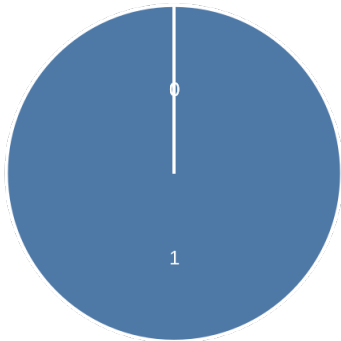

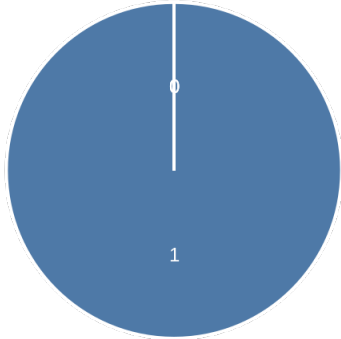
Overall Sentiment
