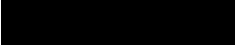

Supervisors,

The voters of San Diego County spoke loudly and unequivocally in 2010 when more than two-thirds of the electorate approved Proposition B, establishing a strict two-term limit for members of this Board . Any effort now to rewrite those limits so you may serve a third term is nothing less than an attempt to overturn the clearly expressed will of the people. Your recent 3-2 vote to place a charter amendment on the ballot that would extend your time in office to twelve years is self-serving, blatantly disrespectful of the 2010 mandate, and—according to one of your own colleagues—“the worst form of politics” .

While you focus precious staff time and taxpayer dollars on preserving your seats, critical community needs continue to languish:

1. Crumbling rural roads and deferred street repairs that make daily commutes and emergency response slower and more dangerous.
2. Over-crowded classrooms and aging school facilities that short-change our children’s futures.
3. A housing affordability crisis that forces working families out of the region.

Instead of tackling these essentials head-on, the Board is prioritizing niche policy agendas:

Expanding boutique winery operations into additional rural-residential zones, complete with amplified live-music allowances .

Pouring years of staff work into a brand-new cannabis regulatory framework aimed at opening more retail, cultivation, manufacturing, and on-site consumption businesses in unincorporated communities .

Wine tastings and cannabis lounges may have their place, but not ahead of safe roads, quality schools, and honest respect for voter-approved term limits.

We—your constituents—demand that you:

1. Withdraw any proposal that undermines the two-term cap approved in 2010.
2. Redirect your legislative agenda and budget priorities toward core infrastructure, public education, and housing.
3. Affirm in public session that the Board will honor the letter and spirit of Proposition B, placing community needs above political self-preservation.

Our ballots already settled the question of how long a supervisor should serve. Honor that decision. Fix the roads. Fund the schools. Put San Diego families first.

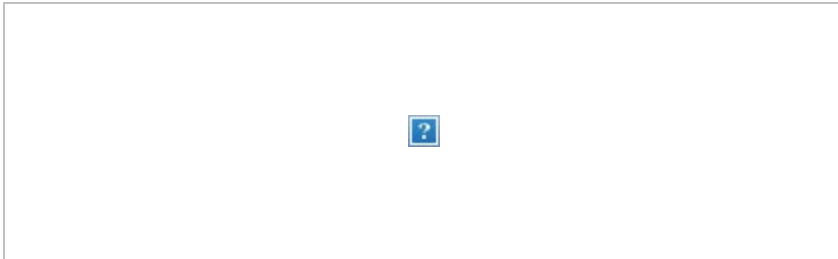

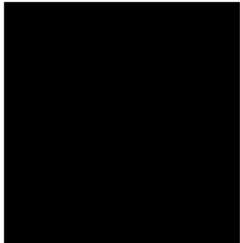
