## FEE CONSIDERATIONS



- 83 HHSA fees were reviewed to ensure full cost recovery while maintaining fees that are fair and equitable for customers and the public
- 44 fees tied to Medi-Cal rates requiring no change, or recommended to stay at status quo
- 39 fees were updated

# TOBACCO RETAIL LICENSING ORDINANCE

- Receive an annual County Tobacco Retail License to sell tobacco products
- Adhere to specific tobacco pricing and packaging requirements
- Not sell flavored tobacco products and adhere to certain operating requirements

### CALCULATION TOBACCO RETAIL LICENSE FEE



- The full cost recovery TRL fee calculated for FY 2022-23 is \$1,460 per Tobacco retailer.
- A three year phase-in approach would set the rate at \$730 per Tobacco retailer, or 50% of full cost recovery in FY 2022-23
