Dear Chair Lawson-Remer, Supervisors Montgomery Steppe, Desmond, Aguirre, and Anderson.

I wanted to reach out personally ahead of Tuesday's vote to thank each of you for your support of the Vista Homekey+ project, and an extra special thank you to Supervisor Desmond and Vice Chair Montgomery Steppe for co-carrying the recommendation. Your leadership is what makes this possible.

This project, 35 units of permanent supportive housing for Transitional Age Youth exiting foster care, developed in partnership with the City of Vista, Casa de Amparo, and TrueCare - represents exactly the kind of targeted, integrated solution these young people deserve. Your \$1.8 million investment will unlock over \$10 million in state Homekey+ funding and \$600k in philanthropy to fully close the gap on a project almost a year in the making -0 that's lightly fast speed for housing!

For youth aging out of foster care in San Diego County, stable housing paired with on-site health, behavioral health, and employment services isn't just helpful, it's the difference between a pathway forward and a slide into chronic homelessness. You are changing that trajectory!

We are deeply grateful for your partnership and look forward to the hearing on Tuesday.
