FINAL LEGAL NOTICE: INTENT TO DISCLOSE PUBLIC INTEGRITY VIOLATIONS (AGENDA ITEMS #8 & #14)

Dr. Rogers, Ms. Hammond, and Ms. White:

This serves as my final formal notice. I will be appearing at the **Tuesday, April 21, 2026, Board of Supervisors meeting** to provide public testimony regarding the systemic failures within IMPACT and the "Inci-Nexus" of corruption within BHS.

I grew up watching the integrity and leadership of **Alfredo Aguirre, Henry Tarke, and Yael Koenig**. I was raised to understand that public service is a sacred trust. The current conduct—specifically the retaliatory, hazardous housing and the conflict of interest involving Deputy Administrator Joseph M. Inci—is a betrayal of that trust.

"The time is always right to do what is right." — *Martin Luther King Jr.*

Let me be absolutely clear: **This is not an attempt to sell my silence.** If your intention is to offer a settlement conditioned on an NDA to "buy" my cooperation, you have fundamentally misjudged my character. I will not be bought, and I will not be silenced while other vulnerable residents remain at risk.

My demands for a resolution before the 12:00 PM Monday deadline are non-negotiable:

1. **Immediate Relocation:** Signed keys and a lease for the independent apartment of my choice.
2. **Reparations for Damages:** I demand fair and equitable reparations for the physical, psychological, itemized and professional damages I have endured due to my placement in a "Zone of Danger," the subsequent medical gaslighting, and the retaliatory actions of this administration. These damages are to be negotiated in good faith starting immediately.
3. **Appointment as Lead Resident Monitor:** I demand a formal, lead figure role in the investigation and correction process. I will not accept a "closed-door" internal audit.
4. **Institutional Restoration:** I demand that **Alfredo Aguirre** and **Henry Tarke** be invited to play lead roles in this investigation and be an integral part of the correction process. Oversight must be returned to the hands of those who built this system with integrity.
5. **Procurement Audit:** A full, public accounting of all CRF/BHS property contracts linked to County employees.

I am hoping for a professional resolution by noon today. However, I am fully prepared for the "worst" scenario for your organization on Tuesday morning. I am aware of the meeting, I am aware of the schedule, and I will be there to ensure that accountability is no longer an abstract concept, but an enforceable reality.

Govern yourselves accordingly.

To the Board of Supervisors:

I am Andrew James Marto, an individual with autism and a whistleblower currently being held in a "Zone of Danger" facilitated by the San Diego County **Behavioral Health Services (BHS)** and its primary contractor, the **IMPACT Program (Community Research Foundation)**.

I am formally demanding that the Board **POSTPONE the vote on Agenda Item #8 (BHS Reorganization) and Agenda Item #14 (Charter Transparency/Accountability)** scheduled for Tuesday, April 21, 2026. You cannot legislate "transparency" while your own Deputy Administrator is allegedly profiting from the squalor of the vulnerable.

I. The BHS/IMPACT Corruption Nexus This is not merely a failure of one landlord; it is a **Reciprocal Corruption Loop** between the funder (BHS) and the vendor (IMPACT/CRF).

- **The BHS Tie-In (Public Corruption):** Deputy Administrator **Joseph M. Inci** occupies a position of power within BHS while simultaneously operating as a private landlord for County-funded residents. This is a direct violation of **Government Code §1090**. BHS leadership has allowed this "Self-Dealing" to fester, effectively using taxpayer money to fund a high-ranking official's private real estate portfolio.
- **The IMPACT/CRF Tie-In (Retaliatory Conspiracy):** The IMPACT Program has acted as the "Enforcer" for this corruption. After I reported the negligence of Mr. Inci, IMPACT engaged in **Retaliatory Housing**, moving me into another sub-standard facility with **collapsing floors, roaches, and bed bugs**. By participating in this "Bait and Switch," IMPACT has breached its contract with the County and its duty of care to me.

II. The "Amy J. Knox" and "Oak Park" Precedents The County is already under fire for the **\$4 million Amy Knox fraud scandal**. My evidence proves that the "Knox Rot" is systemic. Furthermore, I remind this Board that the **"Friends Helping Friends" facility in Oak Park**—the site of the **December 2024 murder of Dennis Robinson**—was allowed to operate under the same negligent BHS oversight that oversees my current "Hot Pot" placement. Under **People v. Tran**, you are now on notice that this pattern of abuse carries criminal liability.

III. Final Demands for Tuesday I demand that the Board pull Items 8 and 14 from the agenda until a full **Grand Jury Referral** is made and the following is resolved:

1. **Immediate Independent Relocation:** My placement in the independent apartment of **my choosing**, as originally promised by IMPACT.
2. **Termination of Conflict:** A formal freeze on all County payments to facilities linked to Joseph M. Inci.

3. **Code Enforcement Audit:** An immediate "Yellow-Tag" inspection of all current IMPACT-managed ILFs.

As **Michael Turko** said, **"IT AIN'T RIGHT!"** You cannot take a "victory lap" for transparency on Tuesday while I am enduring medical torture in a slum your Deputy Administrator facilitates.
