BY THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC FINANCE AUTHORITY NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on February 25, 2025 at 1600 Pacific Highway, Room 310, San Diego, California, 92101, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego (the "Board") will conduct a public hearing (the "Public Hearing") at which the Board will hear and consider information concerning the proposed issuance and sale, from time to time, pursuant to a plan of finance, of one or more series of tax-exempt, qualified 501 (c) (3) revenue bonds and/or faxable revenue bonds by the California Public Finance Authority (the "Authority") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$120,000,000 (the "Revenue Bonds") for the benefit of a California limited liability company (the "Borrower"), to be formed by and whose sole member is Provident Resources Group Inc. (the "Corporation"), a Georgia nonprofit corporation and corporation described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. The Authority will loan the proceeds of the Revenue Bonds to the Borrower pursuant to one or more loan agreements (the "Loan Agreement") to finance a filve story Will loan the proceeds of the Revenue Bonds to the Borrower pursuant to one or more loan agreements (the "Loan Agreement") to finance a five-story residential rental project to consist of 182 units with 147 residential parking spaces at 6650 Montezuma Rd, San Diego, California 92115 (the "Project"). The Project will be owned by the Borrower. With San Diego State University approximately one mile away from the Project, its proposed 552 residential capacity is expected to be marketed to undergraduate students.
