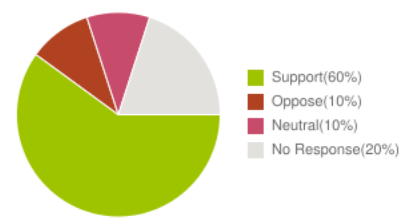

Overall Sentiment



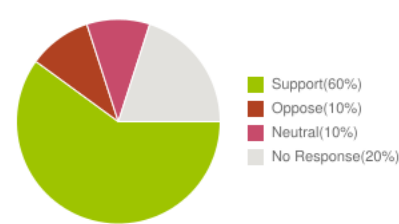

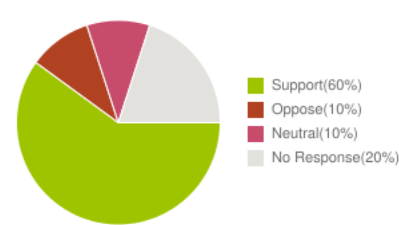
