About item 11, AUTHORIZING A JOINT APPLICATION TO THE HOMEKEY PROGRAM

If you want to bring the homeless and especially elderly and other people who might have serious allergies or other medical issues, you should not be waiving the California Environmental Quality Act. I think that it is **disgraceful** that you would consider placing 4,430 people with a disability and 2,062 people 55 years or older (**both more vulnerable to environmental issues than most**) in housing not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act.

I also believe that funding sources need to be specified clearly, which they aren't, before you commit to requesting **our tax dollars** from the California Department of Housing and Community Development, Homekey program funds.
