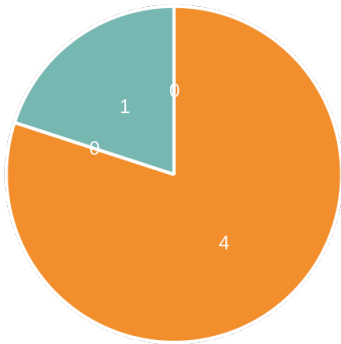

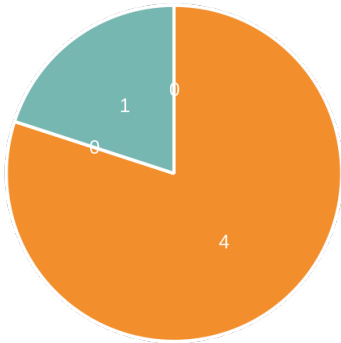

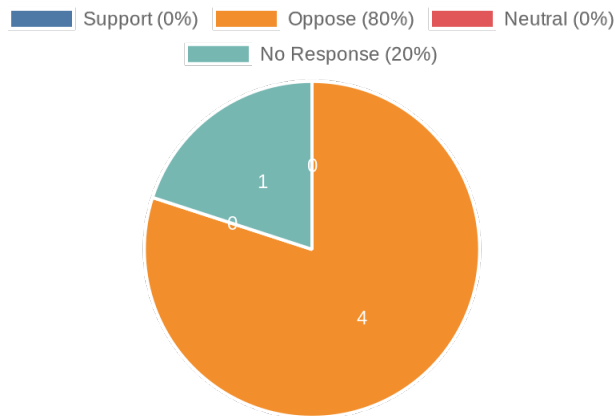
Overall Sentiment
