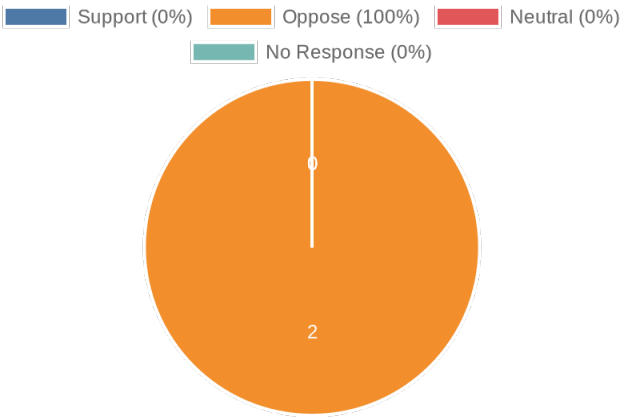

Overall Sentiment

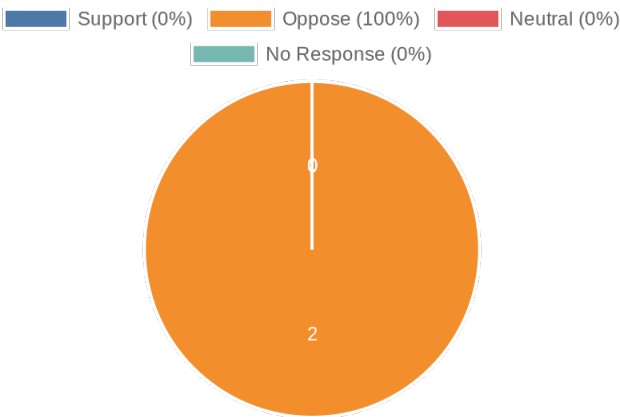

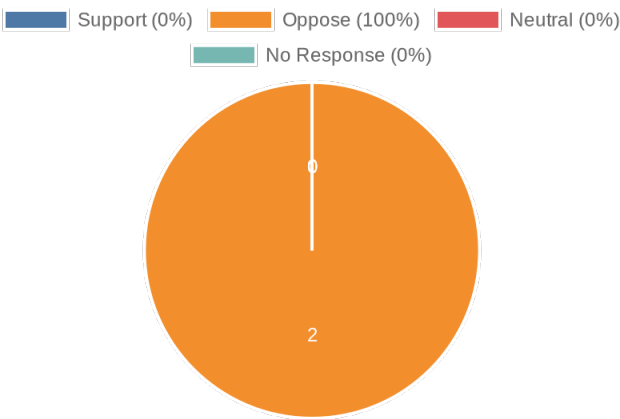

There are huge increases to building fees just as housing prices are coming down. Is this to make up for lower prices? Or does County Fire want to discourage homebuilding or improvement? Building permit increase of 42 or 52% for non-commercial buildings but a decrease of 30% for commercial buildings i- way to discourage new housing. 100% increase for grading plan review – who doesn't have one in this hilly County?

There are a few decreases here and there, but this favors business and discourages housing. Will result in rent increases too. The fee increases are way over inflation. There are pricey new fees.

Ambulance fees are more reasonable, but the 20% increase in base hospital designation to \$73 thou may discourage new base hospitals in East County, .

Moreover, if the Fire Mitigation Program (agenda #FP02) can keep to a 3.6% increase, that means that a 40 to 100% increase is totally outrageous.

You need to rethink what these fees will do to the County.
