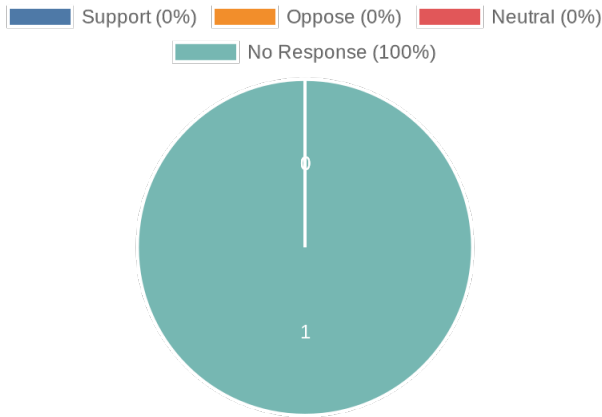

Overall Sentiment

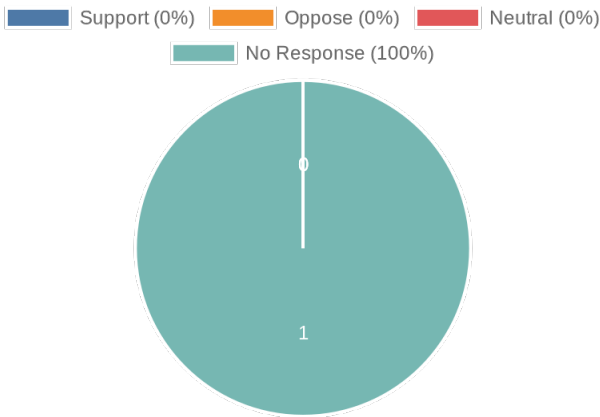

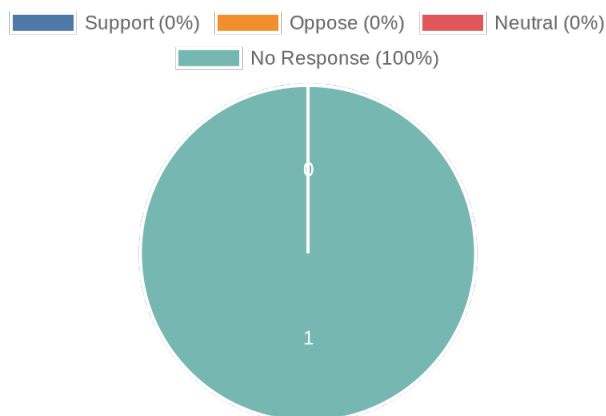
