29. ADOPTING A BOARD POLICY ON IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT TO ENHANCE COMMUNITY SAFETY

I do not think that ICE agents should be allowed in booking facilities PERIOD. Once they are in, they are in and can surreptitiously record, maybe even ask questions amounting to an interview.

Moreover, procedure 1 should specify which facility, if any, which ICE agents are allowed to access.

I would also suggest that if the ICE is allowed to interview any prisoner, it should be done in an area away from other prisoners.

Section V(5)B of the procedures needs to be changed from 'discouraged' to 'shall not.' We should not let other agencies arrest people at or in San Diego County facility. If they can do so, this entire discussion is pointless.
