AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE 9, DIVISION 6, CHAPTER 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO
COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE COUNTY FIRE
CODE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the San Diego County Fire Protection District has adopted, and the Board of Supervisors has ratified, the 2023 Consolidated Fire Code. The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal the County Fire Code, located at Title 9, Division 6, Chapter 1 of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances, in its entirety.

Section 2. Title 9, Division 6, Chapter 1 of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in the Daily Transcript, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
