Single source contracts for the procurement of School-Based Outpatient Behavioral Health Services are being requested with existing contractors (Attachment A). These providers qualify for single source contracts based on the following section of Board Policy A-87 Competitive Procurement 3.C.3 - Continuity: The procurement is for goods and/or services where continuity of providers will allow the County an opportunity to leverage previously initiated work, or benefit from efficiency or critical knowledge, that other sources of the goods and/or services cannot provide or would require substantial re-work to perform.

Additionally, execute a contract for the Community Psychiatry Residency Program with the Regents of the University of California is being requested. This provider qualifies for a categorical exemption based on the following section of Board Policy A-87 Competitive Procurement, based on Section 2.A.2 - Educational Services: Procurement of classroom or course based educational services from a non-profit or public institute of high education, professional association or similar provider.
