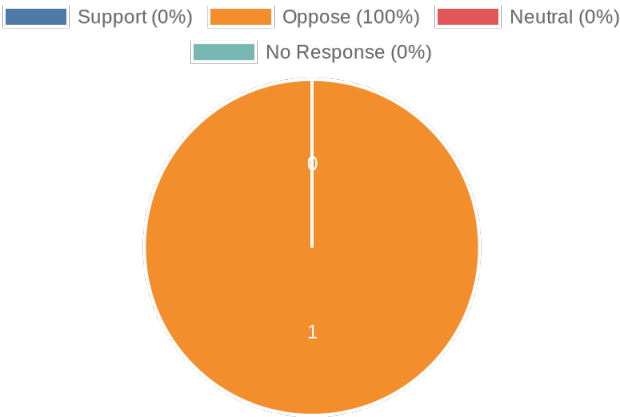

Overall Sentiment

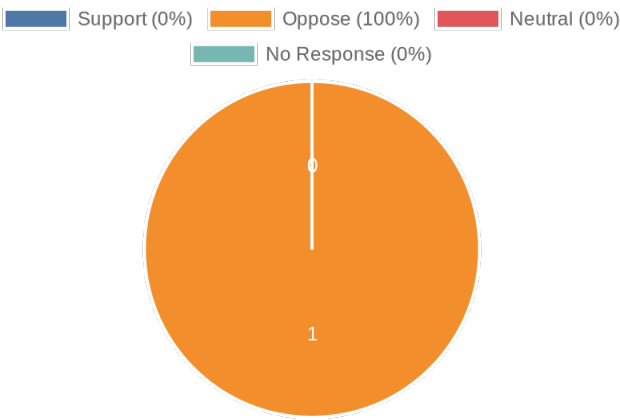

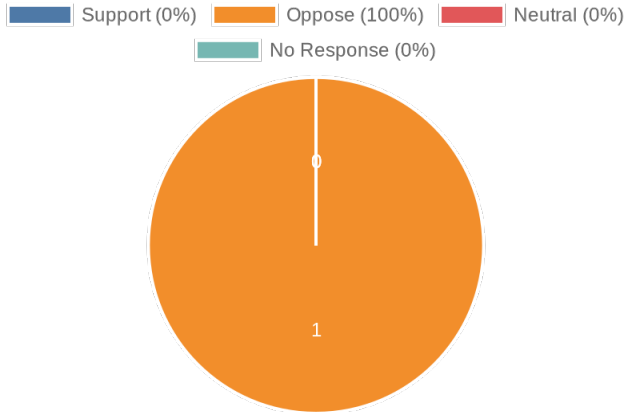

What concerns me most is that this authorizes the County Counsel to pursue litigation up the appellate 'chain,' which could involve the County in significant costs and consequences.

It also seems to me that item (f) is wrong, and should be deleted. If the County places a juvenile in detention or placement by Court Order, the County should be responsible for the cost of that placement.

Item k (eviction) should specify "regarding County-owned property" like item l.

Item n opens the door to unnecessary litigation.

This is not a dictatorship and the decision whether or not to initiate litigation affects the County and ultimately may involve every one of us in the consequences. The decision therefore needs to be a joint decision. The Board should not be abdicating its authority.
