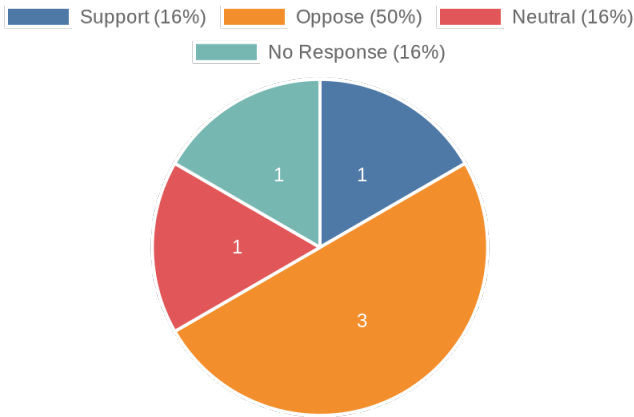

Overall Sentiment

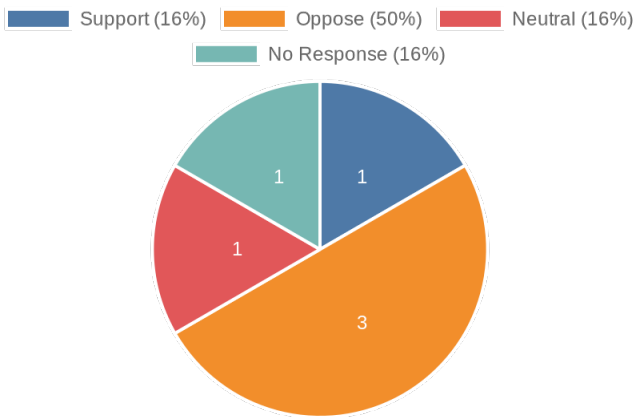

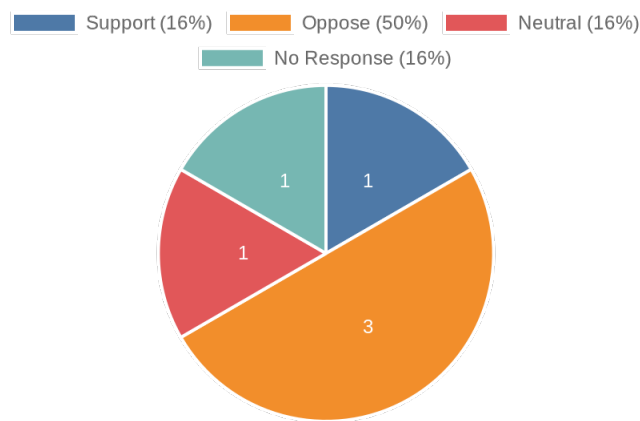
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Overall Sentiment

I reported several damaged and very dangerous guardrails along county route S-16 approximately 2 months ago and as of 6/6/2026, they have not been repaired. In communications with PW staff who acknowledged my report, they are waiting for the contractor to complete the repair. These damaged guardrails pose a significant threat to the health and safety of motorists traveling this mountainous winding 2 lane roadway. There are two damaged guardrail heads that pose a spearing hazard and multiple other locations that have previously been impacted and as a result the strength and integrity of the rail to perform its life saving function is compromised. The contractor responsible for this repair is negligent in its responsibility to respond to this repair request and exposes the county San Diego to potential litigation as a result of their negligent response. I urge the Supervisor's to expedite inspection and repair of this roadway and to investigate the slow response from the contractor.
