

## SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Notice is Hereby Given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption:

### AN ORDINANCE ADDING ARTICLE LXV OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCES RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCESS TO COUNTY FACILITIES

This ordinance will impose restrictions on access to non-public areas of County facilities by law enforcement, require signage related to law enforcement access at County facilities serving the public, and require certain conditions in County agreements related to cooperation with law enforcement, confidentiality of personal information, signage on County facilities, and notice to the County of requests from law enforcement. Said proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on January 13, 2026, at which time public testimony will be received. The proposed ordinance will be presented for adoption on January 28, 2026. Interested persons are encouraged to review the text of the proposed ordinances in detail.
