





I write this comment of public support to highlight key principles in policy A-140 that support responsible Al design, deployment, and use:

- * Right to override: All Al decisions can be overridden by a County worker in direct contact with an impacted constituent
- * Right to opt out: People impacted by AI systems can appeal negative outcomes to County staff who will be empowered to resolve the situation.
- * Public notice of AI and surveillance systems so workers, unions, and other impacted stakeholders provide proactive input into technology deployments.
- * Annual reporting of AI and surveillance systems so impacted stakeholders can make informed decisions to revisit or reject AI as times and circumstances change.

We note that these policies do not apply to the County Assessor or County Sheriff. As workers have come under attack by intensified federal immigration enforcement, there are important AI and surveillance technologies under the purview of these other offices and agencies.
