

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III SECTION 66.1 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING TO THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III SECTION 66.4 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING TO THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT

These ordinances update and clarify language as part of the ongoing sunset review of San Diego County Administrative Code sections. The requested actions represent minor, non-substantive changes to align with current practices and terminology. The proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, at which time public testimony will be received. The proposed ordinances will be presented for adoption on Tuesday, November 18, 2025. Interested persons are encouraged to review the text of the proposed ordinances in detail.
