Hi Supervisors,

This is one example of the dangers of a popular but unfunded mandate.

In any case, a letter requesting funds would be appropriate, and is essentially part of the process, although the primary recipient would be the Commission on State Mandates.

SB43 says "SEC. 7. If the Commission on State Mandates determines that this act contains costs mandated by the state, reimbursement to local agencies and school districts for those costs shall be made pursuant to Part 7 (commencing with Section 17500) of Division 4 of Title 2 of the Government Code."

This is a sensible request that the State should have foreseen.

On the other hand, we may have unused inventory in the county, such as unused hospital beds I've heard about. We need funds, but perhaps we can go ahead with what we have.
