### **EQUITY IMPACT STATEMENT**

The County of San Diego (County) is committed to promoting a culture of equity, belonging, and racial justice. The questions in this tool ensure that the County applies an equity lens when developing the budget.

The County of San Diego (County) is working towards a sustainable future for everyone. Our strategic plan guides our activities to ensure sustainability in the region's economy, climate, environment, and communities. We aim to strengthen communities by pursuing legislative policies and collaborating with stakeholders to enhance services that help residents become self-sufficient, increase economic sustainability, and reduce poverty.

County departments contribute by implementing their own sustainability plans, which reflect their priorities and inform financial planning and decision-making. **BACKGROUND**

The Chief Administrative Officer's Recommended Operational Plan for Fiscal Years 2026-27 & 2027-28, the County of San Diego's (County) budget, is prepared according to the California County Budget Act and the San Diego County Code of Administrative Ordinances. This plan provides an overview of resource allocation for programs and services that support the County's goals over the next two years. It includes various funds and districts under the Board of Supervisors' control, including the Flood Control District, In-Home Support Services Public Authority, Sanitation District, San Diego County Fire Protection District and the County Successor Agency.

Public hearings on the Recommended Operational Plan, including the Flood Control District, In-Home Support Services Public Authority, Sanitation District, San Diego County Fire Protection District, and the County Successor Agency, will begin on June 1, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. If necessary, the hearings may continue daily or otherwise until concluded at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, 2026.

The Recommended Operational Plan document has been available for public review since May 18, 2026, on the County website <https://sandiegocounty.gov/budget> and at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, 1600 Pacific Highway, Room 402, San Diego, California 92101. Online tools allow the public to submit comments on the budget, and materials are provided in multiple languages in accordance with Board of Supervisors Policy A-139, *Language Access*. Written testimony must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board, and comments will be accepted until the close of the budget hearings at 5:00 p.m. on June 11, 2026. Requests for changes to the Recommended Operational Plan must be received in writing by the Clerk of the Board by 5:00 p.m. on June 11, 2026. The Board of Supervisors will deliberate and consider adopting the Recommended Operational Plan and any changes on June 25, 2026.
