Good Afternoon, Supervisors,

This is not a routine matter. It concerns public safety, revenue, and jail conditions and needs a full airing and discussion.

No actual agreement attached. - just that the existing contract is old so let's scrap the old and hope the new is OK. Hopefully the Sheriff Department does not make proofreading errors like most of us do.

It is irrational if not crazy and disturbing is that the Sheriff wants the County to scrap a Lease Agreement for "the financing, construction, maintenance, and operation" of the San Diego Central Jail, related MOU's, and the operating agreement for Las Colinas, and instead substitute a fee agreement "for the booking and release of certain misdemeanor arrestees by the City" through June, 2028.

So this would seem to make financing dependent on certain arrestees, and apparently make maintenance and operation more or less arbitrary than routine.

And then according to the fiscal summary, you would lose \$5.2 million as well.
