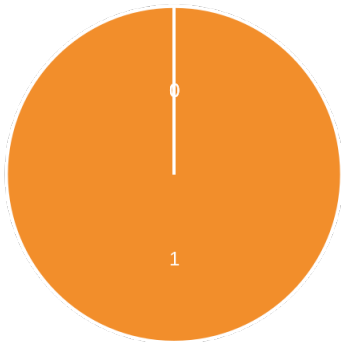

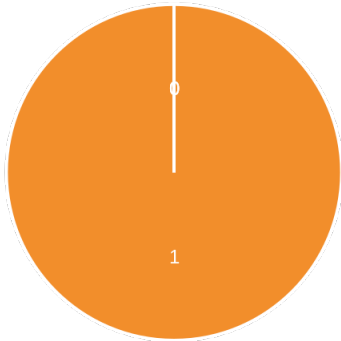

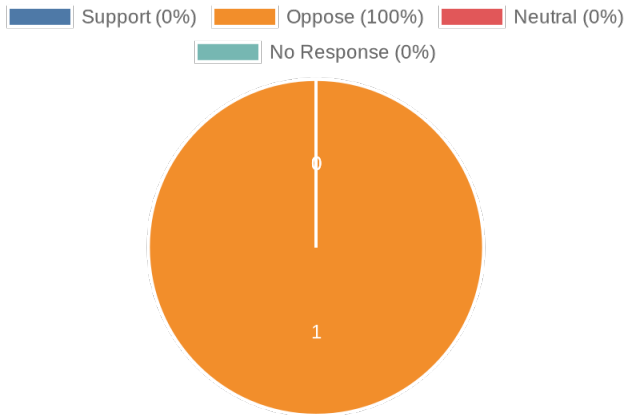

The HHS Housing & Community Development Services (County Housing) seem to think this is the County of San Diego | FY 2026-27 Annual Plan for the whole County. And it mentions a Consortium without defining it.

It seems the department is only required to report on its progress annually not more often.

It reports that the County supported building 220 affordable units, provided rental and homebuyer assistance to more than 12,400 households, and delivered rehabilitation support to 31 homeowners. Public service programs reached over 2,400 residents. Basically a drop in the bucket, considering the number of homeless or low-income people.

Table AP20.01 mentions homeless shelters and services in the urban county only. Outrageous!

Table AP-55.01 shows how little County Housing cares about homeless and special needs people – no homeless to be supported and only 170 special needs people.

Doesn't look like they are meeting their goals. A good case for audit and reorganization.
