

## Agua Caliente Airport

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**Agua Caliente Airport** (**FAA LID: L54**) (Agua Caliente Airstrip) was a public airport one mile northeast of [Agua Caliente County Park](#)<sup>[2]</sup> in [San Diego County, California](#). This airport has now closed. It covered 160 acres (65 ha) and had one runway.<sup>[3]</sup> Agua Caliente translates to "Hot Water" from Spanish.<sup>[4]</sup>

As of May 2014, no aircraft were based at the airport. L54 had no food, fuel or services and limited aircraft parking but no tiedown fees. It was usually a destination for those flying in to visit the geothermally heated Agua Caliente Hot Springs or hike and camp in [Anza-Borrego Desert State Park](#).<sup>[1]</sup>

For the 12-month period ending December 31, 2020, the airport had 4400 general aviation aircraft operations, an average of 367 per month or 12 per day, typically transient aircraft.<sup>[5]</sup>
