RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING RESULTS OF SPECIAL MAIL-BALLOT ELECTION WITHIN PERMANENT ROAD DIVISION NO. 1000, ZONE NO. 9B – HARRIS ANNEX, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPOSITION OF A SPECIAL TAX FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of the County of San Diego (the "County") was petitioned by the owners of property within Permanent Road Division ("PRD") No. 1000, Zone No. 9B–Harris Annex to impose a special tax sufficient to provide for the ongoing maintenance of roads within the PRD; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the petition and in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 1173 and 1176, the Board on March 4, 2026, called a special tax election and designated the Registrar of Voters as a judge to conduct the election; and

WHEREAS, a special mail-ballot election has been conducted in accordance with the direction provided by the Board on June 2, 2026; and

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Clerk re: Preparation and Distribution of Ballots, Receipt of Executed Ballots and Declaring Election Results, (the "Certificate of Election Results"), executed by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors (the "Clerk"), has been filed with the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received, reviewed and hereby accepts the Clerk's Certificate of Election Results and wishes by this resolution to declare the results of the special mail-ballot election.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of San Diego County as follows:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and the Board so finds and determines.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines and declares that the ballot measure submitted to the qualified electors of Permanent Road Division No. 1000, Zone No. 9B – Harris Annex has been passed and approved by those qualified electors in accordance with Article XIIIIC, Section 4, of the California Constitution, and the Permanent Road Divisions Law, specifically Sections 1173 to 1179 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 4. The Clerk of the Board shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter into the book of original resolutions.
