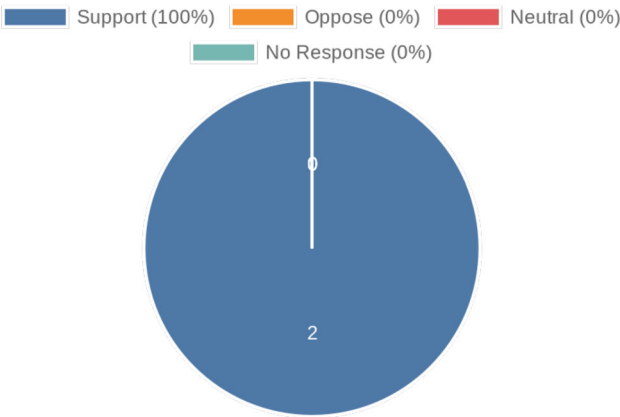

Overall Sentiment



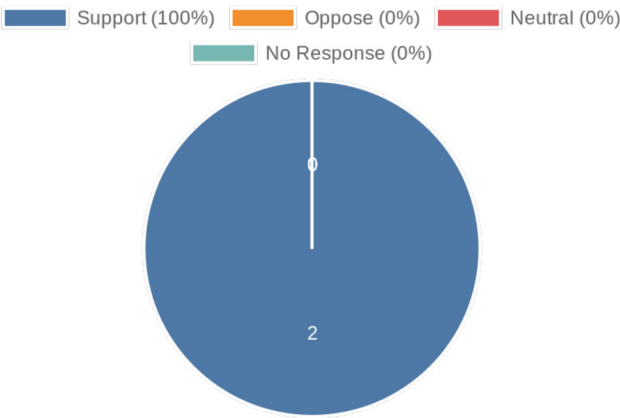

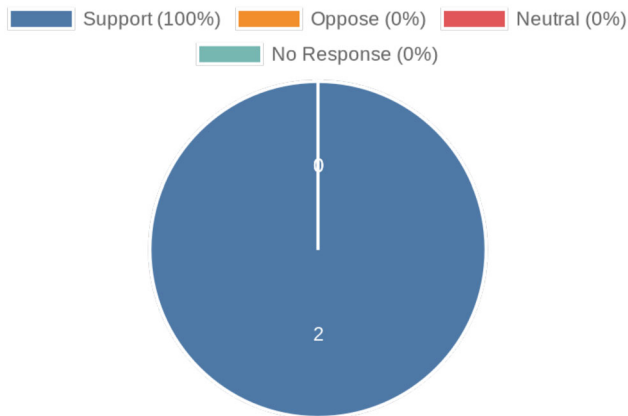

The item has been presented to the Board of Supervisors by the Ramona Cemetery District Trustees with definite restrictions on their future ability to take health benefits through the District and an exclusion of access to stipends for meetings. The biggest reason for expanding the number of board members to 5 is that in the request, 1 of the 3 trustees was absent. Suppose the 2 remaining trustees deadlocked? That is a lot less likely with 5 trustees.

I also do not see how expanding to five members would introduce additional coordination challenges without a proportionate benefit in oversight or performance. Would you want the Board of Supervisors to have only 3 members?

As long as State law allows it, the Cemetery Board should be allowed to select the best number of trustees for itself.
