If during all those years if I was notified that a recently discharged veteran was having difficulty adjusting, I would willingly help him/her by listening, encouraging and providing contact information for counseling and help from many organizations that offer it.

Instead, I hear of bad news after a veteran goes homeless, does drugs or worse commits suicide, and it is too late to help.

The veteran should not only have a place or person to go to for help with the transition, but should be contacted by a vet who has successfully transitioned.
