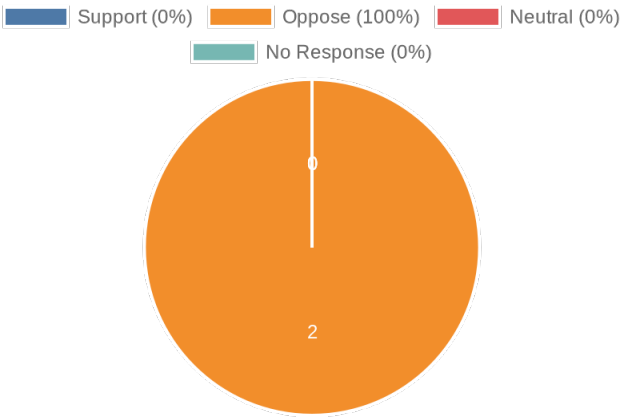

Overall Sentiment



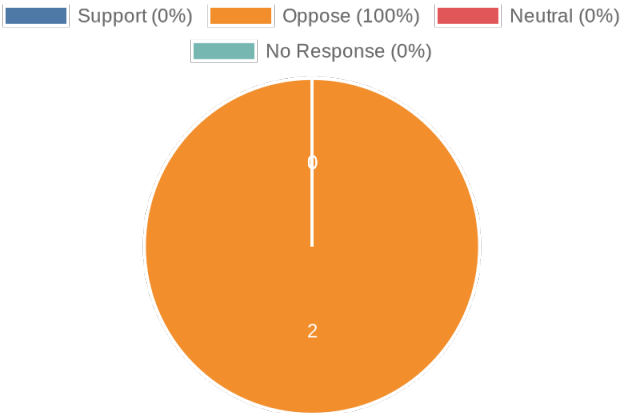

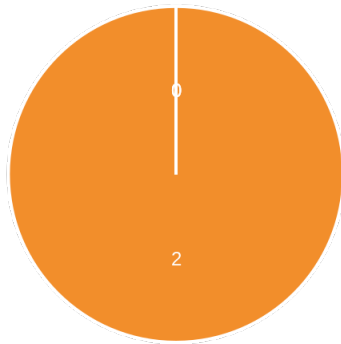
