Hi Supervisors,

The Board wants to retire Board Policy A-110, Zero Tolerance of Illegal Drug Activity in Housing. Does this mean the Board approves of some illegal use? Illegal is illegal for a reason, and there are plenty of alternatives - legal highs on things like pot or shrooms, relaxants like meditation or going for a walk. We do not want to promote criminal activity like drug dealing, gangs, doctors overprescribing opioids, or similar.

The Equity Statement says "the Health and Human Services Agency performs an annual review of Board Policies and County...Codes that are sunseting to ensure alignment with current Board

values and to ensure that they are updated to reflect applicable laws and regulations." Delaying a sunset review by up to 7 years is tantamount to abdicating your oversight responsibilities.
