**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WATER SERVICE CHARGES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26
TO BE COLLECTED ON THE TAX ROLL**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5473 of the Health and Safety Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego has determined that the water service charges of the Campo Water Maintenance District and County Service Area No. 137-Live Oak Springs Water System for Fiscal Year 2025-26 shall be collected on the tax roll in the same manner, and by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, the general taxes of said water systems operated by the County, and has caused to be prepared and filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a written report containing a description of each parcel of property receiving service from the water systems and the amount of charges for each parcel for the fiscal year, computed in conformity with charges prescribed by applicable ordinances of the respective water systems; and

WHEREAS, such report was prepared and filed and a notice of hearing thereon given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, on June 25, 2025, a hearing was held on said report; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has heard and considered all objections and protests to said report and to the fees and charges set forth therein.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. That protests or objection to said report to fees and charges set forth therein has not been made by owners of the majority of separate parcels of property described in said report.
2. That all objections and protests are overruled.
3. That said report, and each and every fee and charge set forth in said report, is hereby approved, affirmed and adopted.
4. That the Clerk of the Board file with the Auditor and Controller of the County of San Diego a copy of said report as approved, affirmed and adopted by the Board, together with a statement endorsed thereon over the clerk's signature that said report has been adopted by the Board.
