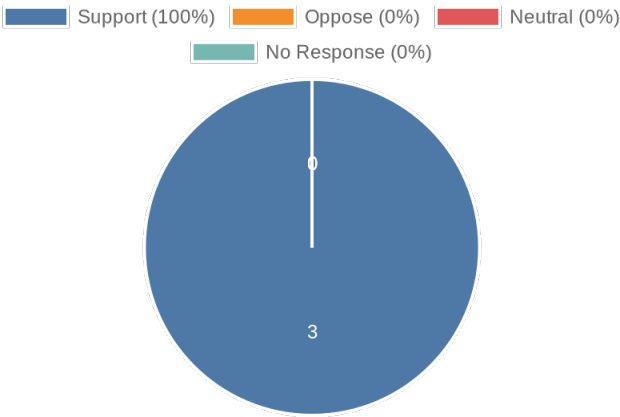

Overall Sentiment

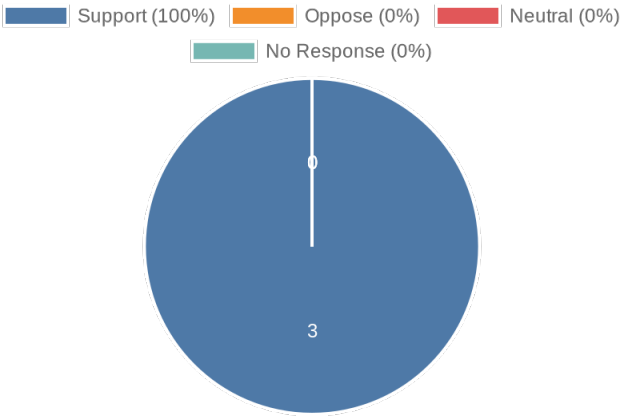

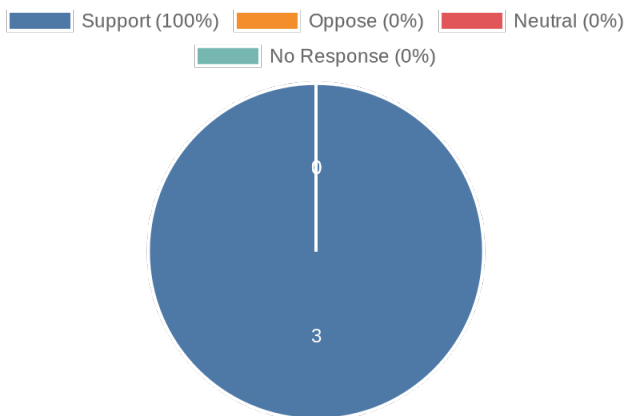

We have EXCESSIVE speeding, hit and runs on our parked vehicles due to narrow streets, a home daycare for children with special needs, an Autistic child that now “Bolts.” Imagine child bolting into the street when someone is racing a vehicle 60 mph in a 25 mph residential zone. The individual was made aware of the child, message politely received, and speeding subsided, but old driving habits have resumed. I've seen double parking in cul-da-sac, illegal dumping next to La Vista Cemetery, vehicles with expired tags parked on the street and illegal motorhome camping. But more seriously, there is a bar in an adjacent city that utilizes the unincorporated streets as overflow parking, plastic red “Solo” cups litter the unincorporated streets of Lincoln Acres which suggests alcohol to be taken off premise. The bar establishment at the 2500 block on Sweetwater Rd is $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to 805 onramp, and 1 mile to Hwy 54.
