





Accelerating Values-Based Food Procurement: County Commitments Under Board Policy B-75 for the Countywide Food Contract

The graphs below show the County of San Diego’s (County) commitments under Board Policy B-75 over a five-year period. They illustrate the accelerated progress anticipated in the Board Policy B-75 value categories for the programs using the Countywide food contract. These commitments are based on the data table included in the Board letter and benchmarked against national averages for similar programs. The metrics track commodity usage by Edgemoor and the Sheriff’s Office, as well as the share sourced locally within San Diego County. We are prioritizing organic and regenerative practices, beginning with produce purchases. This strategy focuses on strengthening local agriculture while promoting quality, safety, and the well-being of those entrusted to our care.
