

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLES XXA, XXXVII, XX, AND XV-B OF THE SAN DIEGO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO JUVENILE FACILITIES, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC DEFENDER, AND FEES AND CHARGES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DIVISION 4 OF TITLE 3 AND DIVISION 10 OF TITLE 6 OF THE SAN DIEGO REGULATORY CODE RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY, MORALS AND WELFARE AND AMBULANCE, CRITICAL CARE, AND NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.

These proposed ordinances will update and clarify language as part of the ongoing sunset review of all Administrative Code and Regulatory Code sections. The requested actions represent minor, non-substantive changes to align with current practices and terminology. The proposed ordinances will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on Tuesday, October 19, 2021. The proposed ordinance will be presented for adoption on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.
