These ordinances update various sections in the San Diego County Administrative Code to clarify language and update information to comply with current statutes and operations, extend and increase the authority of County Counsel to pursue and settle claims and litigation, and repeal obsolete sections regarding incurring and reimbursing expenses for intergovernmental representation. Said proposed ordinances will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on November 7, 2023, at which time public testimony will be received.
