

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_(N.S.)  
**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ARTICLE XXI OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY  
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL REPRESENTATION**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the purpose of this ordinance is to repeal administrative ordinances relating to intergovernmental representation.

**Section 2.** Article XXI, Intergovernmental Representation, of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
