Body Armor

Body armor levels are specified by the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) National Law Enforcement and Corrections Technology Center's Standards. Threat Levels IIIA – Ballistic Vest, IV- Armor ballistic plates and Spike, and protective types (concealed or tactical). The vests come in different outer shell configurations with modular and specific area accessories developed to provide greater protective coverage for neck, shoulder, bicep, groin, and trauma plates.

On four occasions, October 9, 2001 (8), July 13, 2004 (8), September 25, 2007 (3), and December 8, 2009; you authorized the single source procurement of personal protective body armor manufactured by Point Blank Solutions, Inc. (PBSI), Protective Apparel Corporation of America (P.A.C.A) and /Paraclete. It is the Sheriff's Department's goal to provide deputies, community services officers and other specified personnel with the best possible protection against firearms they may encounter in the field. To do this the Weapons Training Unit (WTU) continually researches new products and technologies. PBSI/P.A.C.A. manufactured vests have been found to be superior to the other types and manufactures of body armor and is currently used by the Sheriff. NIJS's National Law Enforcement and Corrections Technology Center's Standards are' 0101.06 for Personal Body Armor and Military fragmentation requirements, and NIJ 0115.00 Stab Resistance for Detentions Personal Body Armor. Body armor must be personally fitted to the individual to meet the elevated safety standards required for law enforcement and authorized standards for the Sheriff.

On November 23, 2016, Request for Proposals(RFP) #7805 was posted for armor which could withstand shots from rifles. WTU tested the samples submitted and a contract was awarded to Spartan Armor Systems for rifle rated armor.

Alternately, the Sheriff's Special Enforcement Detail (SED) is tasked with managing the highest level of critical incidents faced in law enforcement. SED requires a complete modular system configured for extended periods of wear, durability, weight reduction and increased mobility. A formal Test and Evaluation was conducted of numerous providers of advanced tactical assemblies; the TYR Tactical PICO-MV Plate Carrier System, a multi-platform modular design allows it to change and adapt to mission sets with minimal effort and maximum efficiency. The PICO-MV has a wide range of configurations and allows to scale up or down depending on the environment, threat, and load requirements. The carrier system comes in many different outer shell configurations with modular and specific area accessories developed to provide greater protective coverage for neck, shoulder, bicep, and groin areas. All TYR accessory pouches, platforms and trauma plates have been reviewed and approved.

Another type of ballistic protection is the Ballistic Shield. The Sheriff's Department has tested and evaluated ballistic shields and has authorized Armored Mobility Inc, MAS 3818 and 3815 shields.

WEAPONS SYSTEMS – LETHAL AND LESS LETHAL

Both lethal and less lethal weapons systems used for law enforcement are considered "general" and special" issued standardized equipment. The weapons listed on the attached workbook have been selected after being tested and evaluated for consistency of configuration, quality, uniformity, training, efficiency, safety, and interoperability, and have been authorized for use by the Sheriff's Department Weapons Training Unit. Deputies have substantial training on the listed makes and models. To change from these customary weapons would create an unwarranted cost to the department in training and issuance costs and would directly affect the safety of the deputy and the public. All general issue and special issue weapon types, calibers and configurations are specifically oriented to the duty requirements of the deputy. Authority to single source purchase items from specific manufacturers or their authorized representatives or distributors is required due to the need for consistency of configuration, quality, uniformity, training, efficiency, safety, interoperability, and specific use. Only original equipment manufacturer (OEM) parts can be used in repairs to maintain the safety level in weapon systems. The Department authorizes special issued weapons that are configured specifically with enhanced parts and non-standard accessories. The special issue weapons, parts and accessories will be identified for single source requests on a needed basis. The Department is aware of advancements in weapons technology and is continually monitoring for future needs. Authorize the Sheriff to change to different models from the same manufacturers if improved models of weapons systems are tested, evaluated, and accepted by the Sheriff's Department.

Glock – semi-automatic pistol, Model 17, 19, 26, 43 series and 48 series. The Sheriff's Department has been issuing the Glock semi-automatic pistol since 1990 and it is the only handgun currently issued to deputies based on duty requirements. Of the numerous weapons tested by the Sheriff's Department, the Glock was selected because of its accuracy, dependability, durability, and ease of operation.

Replacement Parts and Repairs – For safety of both the public and the deputy, it is imperative that all duty weapons are in top working condition. Only original equipment manufactured parts can be used in repairs to maintain the safety level in weapons systems.

Remington Shotgun – Model 870, 12 gauge pump action shotgun, San Diego Sheriff Configuration – the Remington shotgun is the only shotgun currently used in training at the San Diego Regional Training Center. The Sheriff's Department has been using the Remington 870 shotgun for approximately 48 years and it is the only shotgun authorized for use by the Sheriff's Department.

Remington Shotgun OEM Parts and Repair – it is imperative that the Remington shotgun is in top working condition. Only original equipment manufactured parts can be used in repairs to maintain the safety level in weapons systems.

Colt, and FNH USA M4/AR15 Law Enforcement Models, San Diego Sheriff Configuration – the law enforcement 223 caliber Carbine/Rifles manufactured by Colt, and FNH USA offer different configurations for tactical and increased accuracy at operational distances for improved officer safety. The issued weapons are currently used in the rural areas and contract cities of San Diego County and by the Special Enforcement Detail. The Special Enforcement Detail also uses Accuracy International sniper rifles. The Sheriff's Department has been using the M4/AR 15 Law Enforcement Model for the last 33 years.

Colt, FNH USA Rifle, and Accuracy International OEM Parts and Repairs – it is imperative that the Carbine/Rifles are in top working condition. Only original equipment manufactured parts can be used in repairs to maintain the safety level required in weapons systems.

Remington 870 Shotguns – Less Lethal Configuration – The Sheriff's Department has been using less lethal weapons since 1993. In 1999 the Sheriff's Department tested and selected the Remington Model 870 shotgun less lethal configuration as the designated less lethal weapon for use by uniformed law enforcement. This weapon was designed to fire a small bean bag or a Super-sock round.

Remington 870 Shotguns – Less Lethal Configuration OEM Parts and Repair – it is imperative that the Remington shotgun is in top working condition. Only approved manufactured equipment parts can be used for less lethal configuration construction and repairs to maintain the safety level in the weapons system.

Tippmann/Pepperball Launcher – Less Lethal- on May 16, 2000, the Board authorized the purchase of a Pepperball Launcher, manufactured by Tippmann/Pepperball Technology (formerly Jaycor Technologies). This less lethal weapon was designed to fire projectiles that contain PepperPowder (Oleo Resin Capsicum).

Tippmann/Pepperball Launcher – Less Lethal OEM Parts and Repair – it is imperative that the Pepperball Launcher is in top working condition. Only original equipment manufactured parts can be used in repairs to maintain the safety level in weapon systems.

Tasers – on October 25, 2005, the Board approved the initial procurement of 800 less-lethal Taser weapons. Subsequent Board actions authorized the procurement of additional Tasers, munitions, weapons system accessories, training, and maintenance warranties.

The Special Enforcement Detail requires the ability to single source weapons with special configurations, enhanced parts, and accessories from any manufacturer.

Authority to single source purchase items from specific manufacturers is required due to the need for consistency of configuration, quality, uniformity, training, efficiency, safety, and interoperability. Authorize the Sheriff to change to different models from the same manufacturers if improved models are tested, evaluated, and accepted by the Sheriff's Department.

AMMUNITION – LETHAL AND LESS LETHAL

The specifics for the ammunition listed on the attached spread sheet were selected and authorized after extensive ballistics testing and evaluation by the WTU. Ammunition used must be of the same caliber and known ballistic type. Different manufactured brands of ammunition have an individual ballistic composition profile when fired by the same type of weapon. In law enforcement it is extremely important to ensure consistent point of aim or impact with each round of ammunition. It would be impractical to change the weapon sighting for each different brand of ammunition and is the critical difference in a life and death situation. Purchasing the

DUTY GEAR

The Sheriff's Department conducts continuous safety and wear tests of duty gear from multiple vendors and manufactures. Duty gear is worn by uniformed deputy sheriffs, community service officers, professional staff, and range guards daily. The gear consists of general items such as duty belt, belt keepers, OC spray (mace) holders, handcuff case, magazine pouches, radio holders, key holders, flashlight holder, baton holder, etc. Please see below list for specifications of equipment and its manufacturers that have been approved by the Sheriff as authorized issue for use by the deputy officers and other staff. It is imperative that the attached list of equipment be sourced from the specific manufacturers to maintain safety and professional standards.

Authorize the Sheriff to change to different models from the same manufacturers if improved models are tested, evaluated, and accepted by the Sheriff's Department.

Holsters – The Sheriff's Weapons Training Unit has extensively tested and evaluated a selection of different holsters specific to the conditions for deployment and safety. The authorized holsters' have specific qualities of a heavy-duty reinforced hood guard for use with the department issued Glock semi-automatic pistol. Safety and retention of the Glock pistol were key factors, along with configuration fit for tactical lighting accessories were considered when selecting the makes and models. The weapon safety retention built into the holsters affords the best possible safety and positive control of the weapon system.

Leather Gear – The Aker duty belt (leather) and carrying accessories are personal load bearing equipment (LBE) issued to all Deputy Sheriffs, Deputy Sheriff Detentions / Court Services, Community Service Officers and Sheriff Range Guards. The listed gear and equipment have been selected over many years of safe operational use and testing by the Sheriff's Weapons Training Unit and uniform and equipment committees. It is imperative that this leather gear be durable, wear well, be easy to maintain and standardized for safety and professional appearances.

Nylon Gear – Aker duty belt (nylon) and carrying accessories. Employees, on case by case bases are issued a nylon duty belt and gear. The Nylon gear must be of the same manufactured make and model type and have the standardized appearances as the issued leather gear to maintain safety and the standardized professional appearances. Authorize the Sheriff to change to different models from the same manufacturers.

BADGES

The Sheriff's Department has been purchasing sterling silver uniform and Platiloy flat badges from Entenmann-Rovin Co. for the past 31 years. A survey of various other law enforcement agencies indicated that by far the preferred vendor was Entenmann-Rovin. Purchasing and Contracting has conducted a competitive bid process for the badges in the past and procured badges through two (2) different suppliers who provided poorer quality products and late deliveries. Through the competitive procurement process and the Sheriff's Department previous experience both have shown that Entenmann-Rovin produced a high quality, consistent product at a competitive price.

Badges - The sterling silver uniform badges and Platiloy (silver-colored metal) flat badges were selected and authorized by the Sheriff's Department as the standardized issued badge. Badges are structurally guaranteed for life under normal wear and tear, individually number stamped and lettered

with blue enamel with a small star separating the title and work assignment.

Retired Rocker Identification – The Honorably Retired rocker is soldered onto the employee's badge when they honorably retire from the Sheriff's Department.

Hat Pieces – the design of the hat piece is 100% sterling silver material. The hat piece is placed on the front of the "smoky bear" and/or "cowboy" hat that can be worn by employees and volunteers so they can be readily identified by the hat insignia. The Entenmann-Rovin hat piece matches the standardized authorized badges.

Badge Wallets – The Entenmann-Rovin Platiloy flat badge wallets are issued to each Sheriff Deputy and staff for fit to the flat Platiloy identification badge. The flat badge is carried by the law enforcement officers for identification when they are out of uniform.

TARGETS

Law enforcement agencies require their personnel to undergo weapons qualification testing as part of their initial training and periodically thereafter to maintain their skills. Targets used by the Sheriff's Department for weapons qualification meet the California (P.O.S.T.) Peace Officer Standards and Training specifications; with a scoring pattern outlining the area within which a deputy must land a predetermined percentage of his or her shots to pass the examination. Authorize the Sheriff to change to different models from the same manufacturers if improved models of weapons systems are tested, evaluated, and accepted by the Sheriff's Department.

The Bomb/Arson Unit is responsible for disarming or disposing of explosive ordinance devices. The Sheriff's Bomb/Arson Unit receive specialized Federal training in explosive devices with specialized tools and equipment. Operational policies require that all equipment and tools be standardized for safety. This requires all equipment have absolute compatibility. The equipment and supplies used by the Bomb/Arson unit have a low probability of detonation. They are used to render an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) inoperable by remotely detonating the device from a safe distance. This specific equipment affords the Bomb Officer the ability to perform their duties in a safe manor while conducting Explosive Ordnance Demolition (EOD) operations.
