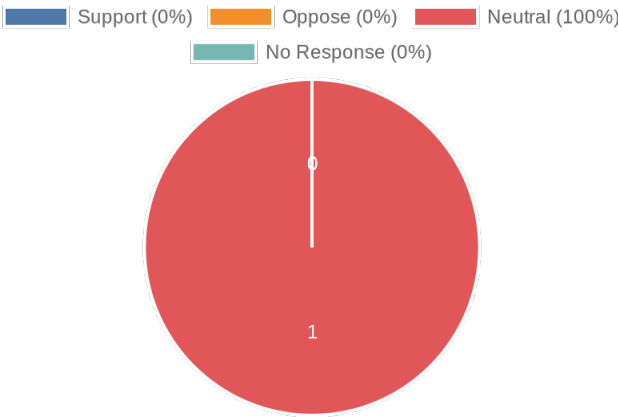

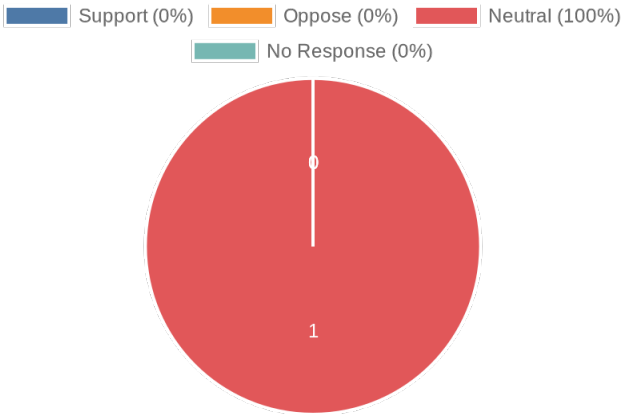

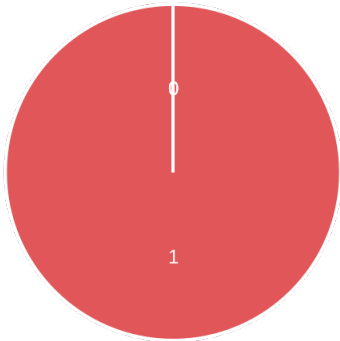
Overall Sentiment

As I said 3/11, A good start, but the ordinance needs to include not only 30 days following the declaration of a state of emergency but also 30 days after any continuance of the emergency. And a 10% rent increase is too high. An unconscionably excessive price (section 31.501) should be 10%, not 50% over the cost to produce that good or service. A ban on evictions without just cause also should include every day of the emergency.

You haven't amended this. I don't want to lock in these rates.
