

ORDINANCE NO. _____ (N.S.)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XX OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCES, RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FEES
The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 370 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is amended as follows:

SEC. 370. EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FEES.

The Deputy Chief Administrative Officer shall charge and collect the following fees for the following emergency medical services:

PERSONNEL FEES

EMT/Advanced EMT Initial Certification/ Recertification - \$146.00

Paramedic Accreditation - \$146.00

Mobile Intensive Care Nurse Authorization - \$146.00

GROUND AMBULANCE

Permit Application - \$3,549.00

Annual Vehicle Inspection - \$325.00

CONTINUING EDUCATION FEES

CE Provider Approval (4 years) - \$1,335.00

HOSPITAL DESIGNATION FEES

Base Hospital Designation - \$24,888.00

Trauma Center Designation - \$47,503.00

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published

once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against the same in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
