BOARD POLICY STATEMENTS:

A waiver of Board Policy A-87, Competitive Procurement, is being requested because the Sheriff's Office has an immediate operational need for Administrative Services Organization (ASO) functions that cannot be met through the current comprehensive medical services contract with NaphCare. The Sheriff's Office has determined that joining the Health and Human Services Agency's (HHS) existing competitively procured ASO contract is the most efficient and cost-effective means to ensure continuity of care, immediate CalAIM claims functionality, and to rapidly address urgent fiscal risks associated with rising off-site medical costs.
