I am writing as a San Diego County resident regarding Agenda Item 10: Second Consideration and Adoption of Ordinance: Modernizing the San Diego County Charter to Strengthen Transparency, Accountability, and Independent Oversight, scheduled for Thursday, June 25.

I write specifically to oppose the provision within this measure that would extend term limits for members of the Board of Supervisors from two terms to three.

The current two-term limit was established by San Diego County voters in 2010 by a 68% supermajority. That limit is not for the Board to change. It was set by the people, and any effort to extend it should originate with the people, not with the officeholders who stand to benefit from it. Three of the five sitting supervisors who voted to advance this measure would personally benefit from a third term. Those same supervisors control how the measure is written and how it is framed for voters. That is a fundamental conflict of interest.

I respectfully ask the Board to vote no on Thursday, June 25.

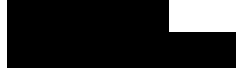

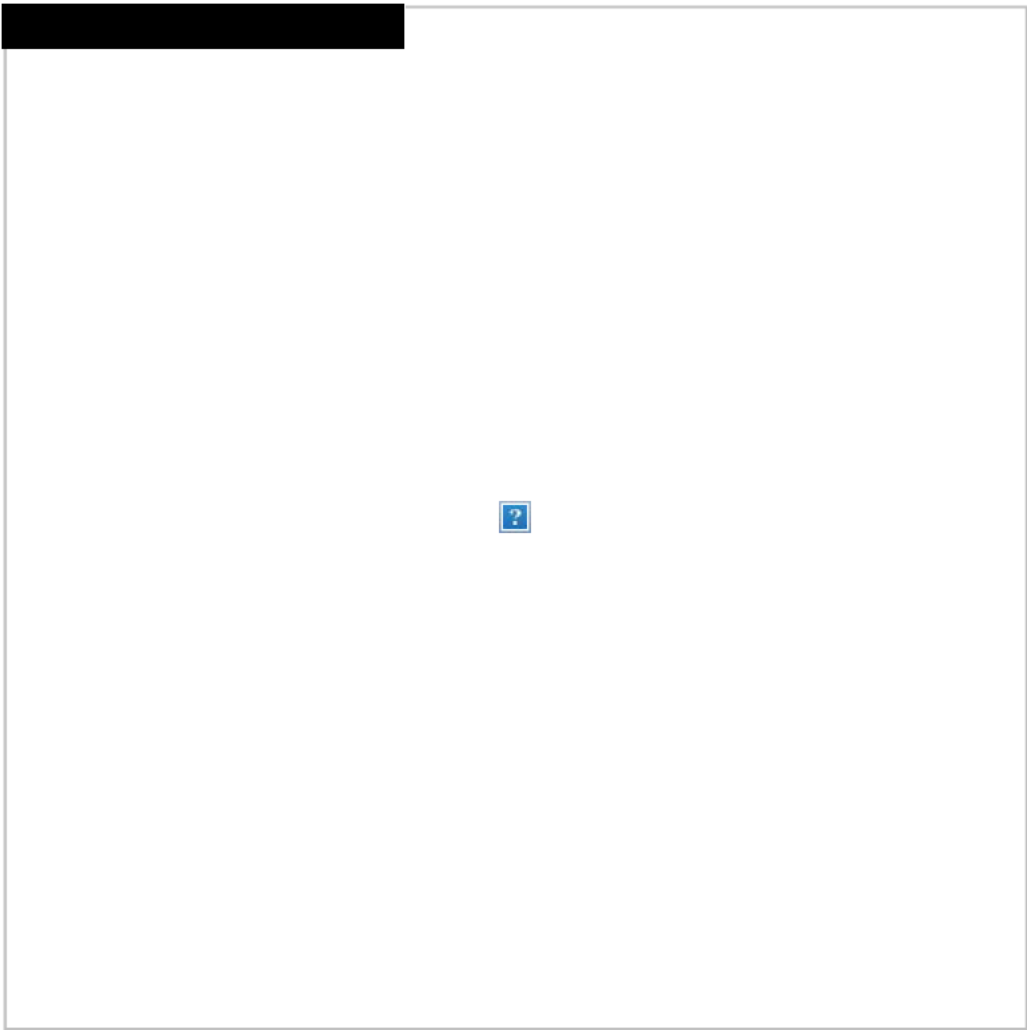
