Subject: [External] Please repeal paid parking at Balboa Park

I am writing as a San Diego County resident to urge you to repeal paid parking at Balboa Park.

My mother's maiden name is Jessop, and my great, great, great grandfather Joseph Jessop helped establish the archery spaces in Balboa Park starting in 1913; in 1917, the official range was approved by the Park Board. As well, most weapons that were collected through the years during the family world tours up through 1974 have been donated to the Museum of Us and are cycled through their displays sometimes; our family has invested in Balboa Park and it is important to us!

Through the years I have come to respect the complicated nature of leadership and in no way do I wish to communicate that the present issues with the parking fees are simple; congratulations and gratitude for your service and I respect that there are myriad pressures to attain the best solution to a tricky problem.

Tuesdays are a key day for me and two carloads of friends who come down to shoot the Rube Powell archery course in the morning, eat at Panama 66, and visit a free museum or two. We usually eat a hearty lunch and try to purchase something in the gift shop each time we visit, financially supporting the park businesses as we can. The parking fee staying in place will mean we may seek out another venue to shoot that is closer to our houses, rather than pay for the parking in addition to the cost of traveling from north county. As well, Thursday evenings I take friends down to walk the park and have dinner listening to the bands at Panama 66; it is a long drive from Carlsbad, but worth it!

My family has always had a vision that the park should be accessible to everyone. Gas, food, rent, and life is expensive and to have a gem like Balboa Park (which is BIGGER than central park in New York) accessible to county residents for free would be a noble, kind, and charitable contribution to the working people of the county, and would support the vision of the early builders of the different park spaces.

I am including language from an email I received from one of the museums in the park. I do not have access to validate these numbers and assume the director of this museum is accurate:

"In just the first week of implementation, the impacts have been severe and measurable. Park visitation is significantly lower than the same period last year. Cultural institutions are

reporting declines in museum admissions ranging from 20% to as high as 57% on some days. Participation in Residents Free Days has dropped between 25% and 50%.

These declines translate directly into lost revenue, projected to exceed \$5 million if trends continue, placing small and mid-sized cultural organizations at serious risk and threatening job losses. This is not a hypothetical concern; it is already unfolding.

Paid parking has created a real financial barrier that discourages families, seniors, students, and residents on fixed incomes from visiting what has always been our shared civic space. Many longtime park users now report limiting visits or avoiding the park entirely.

Equally troubling, early parking revenue appears to be far below projections, raising serious questions about whether this program is worth the damage it is causing to access, equity, and institutional stability.”

I know times are difficult in the leadership world but I hope you will repeal the parking fees at Balboa Park. Two years ago, my friends and I were shooting the course and witnessed the beginning of a fire emanating from highway 163. We immediately called the fire department and by the time they arrived the fire had entered the shooting range fence line and had begun to work its way up the canyon; can you imagine if we had not been there at the very beginning of the fire? The more people that are in the park = more eyes and ears keeping everyone safe, enjoying themselves, and supporting the museums and open spaces.

Balboa Park belongs to all of us. I respectfully ask that you support repealing this program and pursue alternative solutions that do not undermine one of San Diego’s most important public assets.

SUBJECT: Public Health & Safety Analysis: Risks of Eliminating Hard-Wired Landline Desk Phones

Dear San Diego County Leadership, Mayors of San Diego County, and Members of the San Diego City Council:

This message is also being shared broadly with relevant state and federal agencies and community stakeholders included in the CC and BCC fields.

Executive Summary:

San Diego’s decision to eliminate hard-wired landline desk phones may unintentionally recreate a known emergency-communication vulnerability experienced during the September 8, 2011 countywide power outage. As a former public health and safety government regulator, I witnessed firsthand how cordless phones and cell phones failed during that outage, while hard-wired landline desk phones remained the only functioning communication lifeline. I respectfully recommend that the County reconsider full elimination and instead adopt a hybrid telecommunications model that preserves a core of hard-wired landlines for emergency critical departments. Details and supporting evidence are outlined below.

With all due respect, I am reaching out to share my perspective as a public health and safety consultant/advocate and former public health and safety government regulator and private industry consultant. I’m writing to express concerns regarding recent news of the County of San Diego’s decision to discontinue landline desk phones.

While I understand the County faces fiscal pressures, given it spends approximately \$5 million a year to use the Avaya phone system, this cost-cutting measure may pose significant safety risks for emergency response and public health and safety oversight during large-scale power outages.

San Diego's leadership may have already addressed these issues, but in the event it has not, I share my concerns. My perspective comes from lived experience as a former California state investigator, federal inspector, and supervisor with the California Department of Public Health, Licensing & Certification (CDPH L&C), an agency with state and federal jurisdiction over public health and safety.

On September 8, 2011, San Diego experienced a countywide extended power outage that lasted approximately 12–15 hours (depending on the service area), disrupting many essential services, including telecommunications. It was one of the largest power failures in California history. At the time, I worked for CDPH L&C and witnessed firsthand how quickly communication systems can fail when electrical power and telecom networks go down. I share below the telecommunication challenges our public health and safety agency faced during the power outage in the state office building located at 7575 Metropolitan Drive, San Diego, CA 92108.

During the power outage, CDPH L&C was responsible for ensuring that hospitals and other healthcare facilities across San Diego County continued operating safely and without interruption. The agency had to verify if the facilities had correctly implemented their power failure emergency plans, including the proper activation and operation of emergency power generators. Government regulations require that hospitals and other healthcare facilities maintain fully operational emergency generators as a backup safety measure, to ensure continuity of care and prevent risk of harm to patients, staff, and the general public during power outages.

At the onset of the countywide power failure, CDPH L&C San Diego staff were directed to initiate phone contact with management at all Medicare/Medicaid certified hospitals and healthcare facilities to ensure the outage had not adversely affected continuity of care or endangered patients, staff, or the public. CDPH L&C staff who were already onsite, conducting pre-assigned state investigations or federal inspections, shifted their focus to these emergency concerns.

However, when in-office CDPH L&C staff attempted to initiate phone contact with hospitals and other healthcare facilities, we discovered that our cordless phones and personal cell

phones were rendered inoperable due to the power outage. Fortunately, our few remaining hard-wired landline desk phones remained functional because they run on a separate power source independent of the main power grid.

When the power outage caused CDPH L&C's usual forms of telecommunication to fail, the few remaining hard-wired landline phones became our only lifeline. Without them, the agency would not have been able to fulfill its mandated public health and safety oversight and emergency coordination responsibilities.

Without access to hard-wired landline communications during the power outage:

- CDPH L&C would not have been able to make the required phone contact with hospitals and healthcare facilities across San Diego County
- The CDPH L&C District Office would not have been able to reach state investigators and federal inspectors onsite at hospitals and other healthcare facilities
- State investigators and federal inspectors encountering urgent public health and safety concerns would not have been able to contact supervisors, District Administrators, or the District Manager at the San Diego District Office
- In the event an egregious public health and safety situation arose, which required escalation to the federal government, CDPH L&C would not have been able to contact the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), a federal agency under the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
- The same concerns apply to the Life Safety Code department, which is housed within the CDPH L&C San Diego District Office

These telecommunication failures would have reflected poorly on California state government (CDPH L&C), the federal government (CMS under DHHS), and the governance of San Diego — especially if the failures prevented CDPH L&C/CMS from intervening when necessary and resulted in endangerment or harm to patients, staff, or the public. Fortunately, none of these adverse situations occurred because CDPH L&C had a few remaining operational hard-wired landline desk phones in office.

I emphasize the above not only from a quality assurance, risk management, and public health and safety standpoint — but also out of love for my birthplace and hometown, San Diego, and

my desire to help it retain its moniker as being “America’s Finest City” by avoiding emergency preparedness mistakes seen in other U.S. cities.

Ignoring known risks comes with a serious cost. Recent U.S. disasters underscore the consequences of overlooking known vulnerabilities. During the 2023 wildfires on Maui, communication failures and delayed warnings contributed to tragic loss of life despite longstanding awareness of wildfire risk. Similarly, in Kerrville, Texas, severe flooding caused preventable fatalities after documented hazards were not adequately addressed. These events illustrate two examples, within a broader national pattern, where local governance was aware of critical risks yet failed to maintain or invest in essential infrastructure to mitigate them, leading to catastrophic results. Since San Diego already experienced its own telecommunication failures during the September 8, 2011 power outage, eliminating hard-wired landline desk phones would recreate a known vulnerability in communication that has proven deadly elsewhere.

On a personal note, access to a hard-wired landline desk phone at work also enabled me to contact my child’s elementary school to reassure staff (and my child) that I was safe but delayed due to the outage. That landline call allowed me to complete my assigned emergency tasks without worrying that I couldn’t reach my child’s school. When I left work, what would normally have been a 10-minute drive became a 2-hour gridlock nightmare due to traffic jams everywhere.

I mention the next issue to highlight the value of hybrid solutions — where blending old and new technologies results in practical, resilient outcomes. During the outage, I was concerned about running out of gas because roadways were gridlocked and gas stations were inoperable. Thankfully, the hybrid gas-electric vehicle I owned at the time prevented that. My hybrid vehicle achieved fuel efficiency through modern technology (a self-charging high-voltage battery) combined with older technology (a gasoline engine that acts as a generator when needed), along with automatic engine shut-off at stops and electric-only power at low speeds — all ideal for the slow-moving road conditions of that day.

This experience taught me significant lessons about emergency preparedness, particularly the importance of maintaining hard-wired landline desk phones for telecommunication emergencies and how hybrid solutions — combining old and new technology — can save the day. It also led me to no longer view hard-wired landline desk phones as outdated technology, but rather as critical emergency communication infrastructure.

Given the documented risks and the lessons learned from the 2011 countywide power outage, I respectfully ask that the County of San Diego reconsider the complete elimination of

hard-wired landline desk phones. From my consultant perspective, I recommend that the County adopt a hybrid telecommunications model that reduces costs through modernization while preserving a core of traditional hard-wired landlines (connected to power lines independent of the main power grid) in departments responsible for public health, emergency response, and continuity of government.

The hybrid model is widely used in industries where failures in critical infrastructure are unacceptable, such as in hospitals and airports, where lines of communication must remain operational during power outages. A hybrid strategy would help the County achieve meaningful cost reductions without recreating the dangerous communication failures experienced during the 2011 countywide power outage. This approach would maintain essential emergency communication capabilities during power outages, prevent known vulnerabilities from recurring, and align San Diego with best practices used in hospitals, airports, and other critical infrastructure environments.

Page 2 of the document confirms the vulnerability of telecommunications during the outage and highlights the need for landline phones:

“The effectiveness of AlertSanDiego, one of the region’s reverse 911 systems, was severely diminished during the power outage because many residents only have cordless phones that require electricity to work, highlighting the need for residents to maintain a landline telephone in their home that does not require power to operate.”

The article describes situations caused by the power outage, which required CDPH L&C and CMS awareness and involvement, via phone and onsite, including:

- five intensive care unit patients and two emergency department patients had to be transferred to other hospitals
- battery packs had to be used on ventilator patients and monitoring devices
- flashlights had to be used to illuminate areas
- twenty-one high risk nursing home patients were transferred to hospitals

Without access to hard-wired landline communications during the power outage, when emergency generators failed at hospitals and other healthcare facilities, CDPH L&C and CMS would have faced challenges in the oversight of public health and safety. Gridlock on all roadways prevented CDPH L&C from quickly deploying in-office staff to conduct onsite oversight visits at facilities where agency staff weren't already present. Hard-wired landline desk phones, the only reliable form of communication available to CDPH L&C during the power outage, proved invaluable.

San Diego County Leadership, Mayors of San Diego County, and Members of the San Diego City Council – thank you for your service to the people of San Diego and for your commitment to protecting the public's best interests, including public health and safety. I appreciate your attention to my concerns. Please feel free to reach out if you have any questions.

For further transparency and verification, I've also included members of the **Cushman family** in the BCC section. I previously worked for the Cushman family (part-time during my

college years) and am familiar with their longstanding leadership roles and involvement in San Diego's civic, philanthropic, business, and development sectors, including the work of The Cushman Foundation, which supports arts, cultural, and humanitarian programs to give back to the community.

Stephen P. Cushman, his wife Marjorie Cushman, their daughters Lori Moore and Debby Cushman-Parrish, their son-in-law Kent Parrish, and The Cushman Foundation have been closely involved in supporting regional initiatives, public institutions, and community development. Lori Moore is a Registered Nurse with longstanding connections to San Diego's healthcare community and involvement in health-related philanthropic initiatives. Debby Cushman-Parrish has also supported senior care and community health efforts through her involvement with Seacrest Village Retirement Communities. Given the Cushman, Parrish, and Moore families' influence and their deep, ongoing commitment to San Diego's development and wellbeing, I believe they should also be informed of the public safety concerns outlined in this message.

During my employment by the Cushman family, at Cush Auto Group, I worked in the Customer Relations department (led by Debby Cushman Parrish, with Lynda Jones as my supervisor) and in the Receptionist department (led by Kent Parrish, with Tammy Rahders as my supervisor).



Subject: Pala–Pauma Valley Inclusion & Access Initiative – Tribal–County Partnership Pilot

****Purpose****

Request Board direction to advance a Tribal–County pilot program delivering mobile health, legal, and transportation services to underserved residents in Pala and Pauma Valley.

****Background****

Rural agricultural communities in Pala and Pauma Valley face persistent barriers to healthcare, legal services, and transportation. Many residents are undocumented, have limited literacy, and lack access to reliable transportation, resulting in delayed care, increased emergency service utilization, and social isolation. Tribal lands provide trusted, culturally appropriate locations for service delivery that reduce fear and improve participation.

****Proposed Initiative****

The pilot would deploy mobile, community-based services in partnership with the Pala Band of Mission Indians and nonprofit providers, focusing on:

- * Preventive healthcare and behavioral health screening
- * Confidential immigration legal consultations and pathways to naturalization in becoming a US citizen
- * Outreach program for non-native able bodied adults to gain proficiency in reading and writing
- * Transportation assistance to essential services
- * Community Health Workers (Promotores) for outreach and navigation

****Funding Alignment****

Potential funding sources include Live Well San Diego (HHSA), Behavioral Health Services prevention funds, Office of Immigrant and Refugee Affairs legal service contracts, and ARPA or other flexible equity funds. The pilot leverages existing County programs without expanding enforcement activity.

****Performance & Accountability****

Program success will be measured using defined KPIs, including residents served, preventive care uptake, legal screenings completed, transportation access improvements, community satisfaction, and cost per participant. No immigration enforcement data will be collected.

****Equity & Tribal Partnership****

The initiative advances County equity goals while respecting Tribal sovereignty through voluntary participation, joint coordination, and service delivery on Tribal land under a formal partnership framework.

****Recommended Action****

Direct staff to develop an implementation plan and return to the Board with proposed funding allocations, partner agreements, and performance measures for pilot launch.

Good morning, Honorable Supervisors. Thank you for your service.

My name is Larissa Anderson - President of the Bonsall Unified School District for the 6th consecutive year, and Chair of the Bonsall Community Sponsor Group. I am here today because I love my community. I am here today because I love San Diego County. I am here today because I love the United States of America. I am here today because I love Planet Earth.

Both BUSD and BCSG—independently, unanimously—submitted letters urging No Option on the Socially Equitable Cannabis Ordinance. I also spoke before the Planning Commission before this proposal was advanced with even fewer protections.

What's before you today is not simply a cannabis policy. It is a land-use decision with irreversible educational, public-health, and moral consequences—especially for rural communities.

Let me ground this in reality.

Bonsall Unified spans 88 square miles of semi-rural San Diego County. In the absence of appropriate state and local facilities funding, we have tried to build adequate secondary facilities through multiple failed bond measures, each undermined by NIMBY obstructionist politics, FOR DECADES.

We have land constraints.

We have infrastructure constraints.

We have zoning obstacles that make it extraordinarily difficult to site a new school.

At its core, our work in education is about designing spaces to flourish— places that support learning, purpose, health, teamwork, and long-term community stability.

And yet—here is the paradox I need you to sit with: We cannot fast-track a school.

BUT under this ordinance, we can fast-track industrial-scale cannabis cultivation, including in proximity to existing and future school sites, under the banner of social equity.

So let me pose a hypothetical, but a legally plausible one under the framework you are considering:

Imagine a future Bonsall secondary campus—finally built through a public- private partnership because traditional funding failed us.

Now imagine a large-scale cannabis grow operation co-located next door, approved more quickly than the school itself.

- Students arriving each morning to learn.
- Student-athletes training, practicing, and competing as close as 600 ft, 1.67 football fields away
- Young people spending formative hours breathing particulates, handling plant material, and normalizing daily proximity to a product we simultaneously warn them to avoid.

Is that the legacy you want attached to your vote? Is that what equity looks like for rural children?

Because to us, this feels like extraction, not equity. It feels like sacrifice zones, not opportunity zones.

I want to say something personal, carefully and respectfully.

I have a neurodiverse loved one who during COVID, when schools shut down, athletics disappeared, and structure vanished, he struggled—like so many young people did. Marijuana compounded that struggle.

Today, he is a person of faith. And he will tell you—unprompted—that access to cannabis should be MORE limited, not less, than what we have today. Vista is already a cannabis corridor.

Supervisors, you have influence.

Influence and influenza both derive from the same root word.

One describes what moves through a population. The other describes what infects it.

Your votes shape what is normalized.

Your votes determine what is built nearby.

Your votes shape what our children breathe, see, and come to accept as inevitable.

So I ask you to pause and consider this decision not just as policymakers, but as stewards:

Is this the influence you want attached to your legacy?

Is this what you want remembered as the environment you helped create for our children?

This is not about demonizing cannabis.

It is about where, how, and at whose expense we scale it.

If our county can accelerate development that degrades community health faster than it can support schools that lift children toward purpose— schools intentionally designed as spaces to flourish—then something is profoundly out of alignment.

I ask you—on behalf of educators, parents, students, and future generations—

Pause.

Choose no outdoor cultivation (2C), no lounges or events (3B), and do not continue to develop the Socially Equitable Cannabis Program (4B), especially without a legally defensible CEQA.

And do not make this the legacy OUR children inherit. Thank you.

Good Afternoon San Diego County Staff and Distinguished County Officials:

Do we have a precise number of HUD-owned homes in the greater metropolitan area of San Diego or "Zombie foreclosures" (vacant homes abandoned after foreclosure) which are generally included in the broader "vacant" statistics rather than listed separately in public reports?

My understanding of the data as of early 2025, San Diego County recorded roughly **1,000 Notices of Default** (initial foreclosure filings) and **600–800 Notices of Trustee's Sale** (impending auctions) over a 12-month period. Is this accurate information?

Effective July 2025, California signed **AB 130**, which specifically targets "zombie" second mortgages by imposing stricter requirements on mortgage servicers to identify and manage abandoned properties. What county department should have oversight of this data? Is foreclosure activity trending higher in 2026?

Of the 6% (housing stock), roughly 75,000 units, are we addressing other reasons for vacancies such as:

- 26.5% – Waiting to be rented.
- 6.6% – Sold but not yet occupied.
- 6.4% – Undergoing renovations.
- 5.2% – Waiting to be sold.

Does the San Diego Housing Commission have current reports from 2022 to date of Long-Term Vacancies conversions into affordable (**NOAH**) units? A **2021 SDHC** study found only 0.32% to 0.79% of units were vacant for six months or longer.

Key Surplus Land Areas and Sites (2025-2026):

- Mission Bay Park Parcels: The city is focusing on redeveloping 23 acres at Marina Village, 4.5 acres at Dana Landing, and 0.8 acres at Sportsmen's Seafood. These sites are being considered for redevelopment for better public use, with potential for hotels/conference centers, notes Times of San Diego.
- ***La Jolla/Torrey Pines Area:** An empty parcel on Torrey Pines Road was recently declared surplus.
- Former Redevelopment Agency Properties: These include various smaller lots held for disposition by the City of San Diego.

Are we promoting Key Opportunities for **Tiny Home Developers**?

Factory-Built Housing Pilot Program (Through March 2026): California's Strategic Growth Council is running a pilot program for factory-built housing, which often includes modular, or "tiny" homes, with applications accepted on a rolling basis.

Density Bonuses: Within the City of San Diego, developers who build five or more units, including, micro-units or small homes who may be, eligible, for a, 100% density, bonus, in, certain, areas.

Are we providing Alternative Sustainable Tiny Home Developers the following compliance information to support the construction, acquisition, or rehabilitation of new housing units to combat the housing crisis:

City vs. County: Regulations for, tiny, homes, differ, significantly, between, unincorporated, San, Diego, County, and, the, City, of, San, Diego.

Site Suitability: Developers are responsible for determining, property suitability for, tiny, homes, including, utility, access, and, zoning, restrictions.

Greetings:

Regarding the proposed **Empty Second Home and Vacation Rental Tax** will be heard by the City Council's Rules Committee on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, at 9:00.

San Diego's proposed tax on vacant second homes and short-term rentals (STRs) aims to address housing shortages by targeting underutilized properties, with a potential **\$5,000+ tax per bedroom**. The initiative aims to generate up to **\$135 million** annually for housing.

It is to my understanding that potentially **11,000** combined Homeowner's units in San Diego are deemed "empty" or underutilized. What analytical (federal data) are we relying on?

Does the statistical information include annexed guest house(s), which is generally referred to as an **Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU)** which can be assigned a separate address through legalized, permitting and zoning procedures.

More specifically, the submission of an application for a new address, providing documentation such as the building permit, a land deed, and a site plan. Upon approval, the local government agency will assign a unique address to the guest house.

In California, you can sell an Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) separately from your main home under **Assembly Bill 1033 (effective Jan 1, 2024)**, provided your local municipality has opted into the ordinance, often requiring a homeowner association (HOA) to manage these common areas.

Allows owners to generate income and provides, on average, more affordable housing options (**40-60% of single-family home prices**).

While this specific proposal is local to San Diego, it reflects a broader trend of municipalities using tax penalties to manage housing, which can create complex tax implications for owners of multiple properties or it might just trigger sales rather than converting units into long-term, affordable housing.

Other tax implications to reconsider, **non-resident aliens (NRAs)** owning U.S. property already face a **30% tax on income** not effectively connected with a U.S. trade or business, and this new municipal tax would add an additional layer of financial obligation.

Tracking and enforcing tax compliance on foreign owners holding property in entities or directly can be complex, potentially requiring enhanced reporting mechanisms.

Increased scrutiny of empty homes and vacation rentals may be used to identify foreign-owned or shell company-owned properties, addressing concerns related to money laundering or illicit financial flows in the real estate market, prompting local governments to monitor these, which can intersect with local safety and security oversight.

Hoping we can have a broader discussion around Green modular units with passive solar home design using sustainable materials.

Greetings San Diego County Staff and Distinguished Public Officials:

In 2024, San Diego, CA **imported \$7.93B**, making it the **66 largest importer** out of the 367 ports in the United States.

The top imports of San Diego, CA were **Cars (\$5.45B)**, **Electric Batteries (\$621M)**, **Delivery Trucks (\$526M)**, **Crustaceans (\$260M)**, and **Bananas (\$197M)**.

In 2024, San Diego, CA **exported \$908M**, making it the **115th largest exporter** out of the 387 ports in the United States.

The top exports of San Diego, CA were **Planes, Helicopters, and/or Spacecraft (\$206M)**, **Gas Turbines (\$93.2M)**, **Electric Generating Sets (\$51.3M)**, **Laboratory Reagents (\$48.3M)**, and **Semiconductor Devices (\$35M)**

In October 2025, San Diego, CA was the number **125th exporter** and the number **74th importer** in the United States, out of 340 ports.

In October 2025 San Diego, CA **exported \$52.1M and imported \$436M, resulting in a negative trade balance of \$34B.**

San Diego, CA exports mostly to Czechia (\$12.3M), Ecuador (\$9.87M), Netherlands (\$9.07M), Japan (\$3M), and Brazil (\$2.86M).

San Diego, CA imports mostly from South Korea (\$164M), Mexico (\$74.6M), Germany (\$46.5M), Ecuador (\$45.4M), and Guatemala (\$23.2M).

In 2024, we focused on the **Otay Mesa II Port of Entry** to reduce congestion. Domestic investments driven by imports focus on cross-border manufacturing (specifically with Mexico), logistics, and, for 73% of foreign direct investment, the **life sciences sector.**

These efforts are supported by over **\$1.5 billion in foreign direct investment** (as of 2022). Investments driven by foreign partnerships, such as those that supported **Samsung's expansion in the region.**

Concerns regarding Samsung's activities in the San Diego/Tijuana region involve shifting manufacturing strategies due to 2025 tariff uncertainties, intense energy/water demands and center on potential environmental impacts, high operational costs, and shifting trade policies.

Semiconductor manufacturing is highly water-intensive, consuming roughly 2,200 liters of ultra-pure water per day per fabrication plant, posing sustainability challenges in the region. Operations in Tijuana have necessitated specialized security measures due to regional criminal activity.

Are there construction progress updates on SANDAG in partnership with Caltrans, in the development of the **Otay Mesa East Port of Entry (OME POE)**, a \$1.3 billion, "smart" border crossing designed to boost trade, enhance regional mobility, reduce emissions, and potentially save jobs? My understanding is that this is a key project for our State.

Infrastructureally, this project includes the **new port of entry**, a **California Highway Patrol commercial vehicle enforcement facility**, and a 4-lane toll road. It is expected to generate **\$1.8 billion** in economic gains. The project has also secured the necessary Presidential Permit for the new border crossing. The project is estimated to decrease carbon dioxide emissions by 395,596 tons over its first 20 years, supporting California's climate goals.

We should be in FULL cooperation with federal partners, such as U.S. Customs and Border Protection, regarding the operation of the new facility.

Dear Chair Lawson-Remer and Members of the Board,

I am writing to you today as a constituent of District 3 to formally express a Vote of No Confidence in the leadership of Director Kelly Campbell and to call for her immediate removal from the Department of Animal Services (DAS).

As the Board prepares for the opening of the Santee facility later this year, it is imperative that we address the management crisis currently resulting in substandard care and unnecessary euthanasia at our existing shelters. Director Campbell has had sufficient time to stabilize the department, yet the following failures remain systemic:

Gross Negligence of Volunteer/Foster Pipelines: Under Director Campbell's tenure, the volunteer and foster programs have been allowed to collapse. Hundreds of San Diegans have applied to help, yet they remain stuck in a broken vetting process with no leadership to move them forward. This administrative bottleneck is the direct cause of the current "overcrowding."

Violations of Standards of Care: Management has failed to enforce basic humane protocols at the Bonita and Carlsbad shelters. Reports continue of animals being hosed down while inside their kennels and being denied proper bedding—clear violations of the standards of care the County is legally and ethically bound to provide.

Additionally, upon entrance to the shelter environment, animals are not assessed and treated humanely. They have been routinely dragged down hallways and placed in high traffic areas.

These animals are frightened and bewildered; they are subjected to undue stress and through no fault of their own become withdrawn and less adoptable. This is not considered best practice and is an outdated and inhumane way of managing transition for shelter animals.

Administrative Euthanasia: We are witnessing the euthanasia of healthy, treatable animals because the department has failed to approve the very foster homes and rescues that are waiting to take them. This is a tragic and preventable failure of policy and administration.

A new building in Santee will not fix a leadership culture that fails to prioritize animal welfare or community partnership. I respectfully urge the Board and the Chief Administrative Officer to replace Director Campbell with a leader who will restore integrity, transparency, and humane standards to the Department of Animal Services.

Good Afternoon, Paloma,

It's good to meet with Federal reps. and try to get money, but the Feds and State are basically broke, and the County isn't in good financial shape at all. So asking for money is no longer something we can rely on, and repeated studies instead of action is not a good substitute (also has the effect of delaying the fix.)

While air purifiers are good for those who need them, they are limiting as soon as you want or need to go outside.

We should be doing local solutions, like the above ground drainage system proposed at the last meeting, similar to a suggestion to line the river banks with concrete I made a few years ago. The reason I favor this over a subterranean and long pipeline is that a pipeline might be more expensive to go in and fix.

We should also get hand-held pollution monitors to zero in on the sources of the pollution, which may be as simple as a cracked vent.

And local solutions might attract more volunteers.

Dear Paul Henkin,

This week, I met with the head of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to push for urgent federal action on the Tijuana River pollution crisis.

Why does that matter to you?

Because toxic air, sewage contamination and years of beach closures aren't policy debates - they're a daily health risk for South Bay families. And our community has waited far too long for real solutions.

That's why I was clear with the EPA: we need action now.

While we continue fighting to stop pollution at its source, the

County hasn't stood still. We've secured funding to expand the free air purifier program, helping thousands of households breathe safer air at home right now.

Air purifiers are a critical step but they're not the finish line. This meeting was about making sure the federal government does its part to end this crisis for good.
