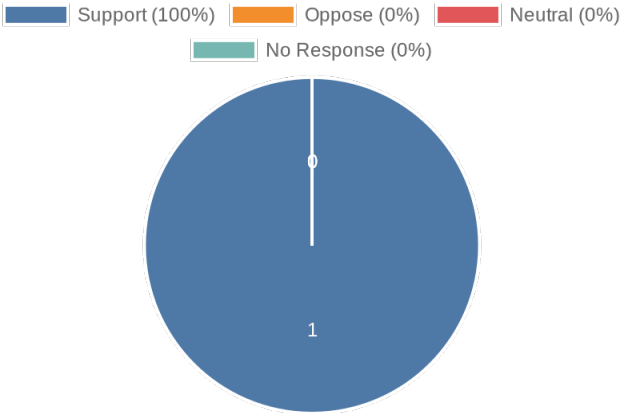

#### Overall Sentiment

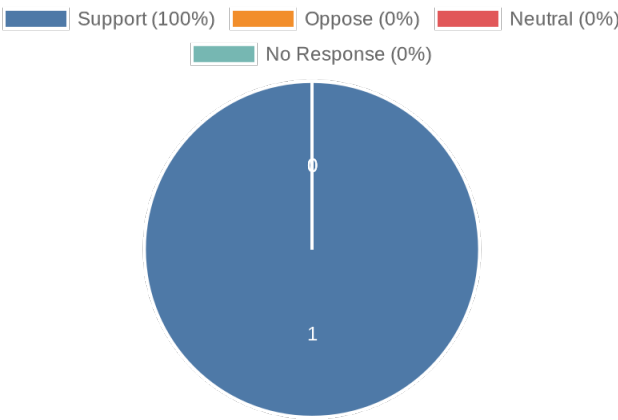

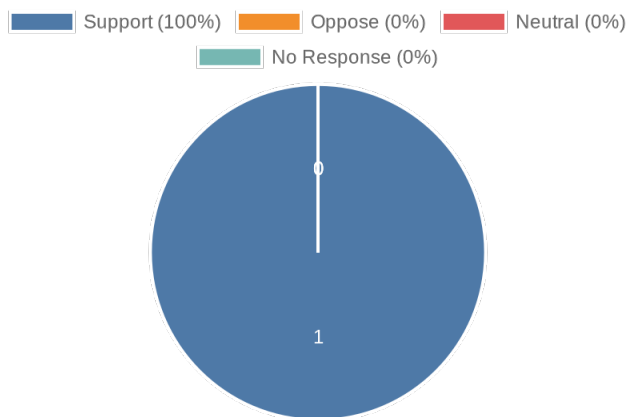

On the military use report, it is very thorough, except the description under Military Training UNIT of “43 Miscellaneous Firearms of various calibers, makes, and models, which qualify as assault weapons” defeats the purpose of tracing these if it gets used improperly on the public.

Also, there should be more than 4 pepper ball launchers which are cheaper than guns and probably work better at de-escalating a conflict.

And since the price is not prohibitive and the value in generating evidence to convince a resisting offender to drop his attack is great, wouldn't be bad to get a few more, especially if one breaks down.

On the Amendment, it would be nice to have a version indicating what changes have been made.
