**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN
DIEGO DECLARING THAT THE LAND IDENTIFIED IN DIRECTORS DEED
DD16450-01-01 WILL BE USED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2024 (21), the San Diego County Board of Supervisors (Board) directed staff to develop a State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) owned site located at 2800 Sweetwater Rd in Lemon Grove (Property) site into an emergency shelter for people experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans requires the adoption of a Resolution stating that the Property will be used for public purposes if the Board approves the purchase, as well as the specific intended use of the property; and

WHEREAS, staff determined that the Property's location, topography and size, combined with accessibility makes this a desirable site for future public purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board hereby declares that if the Board approves the acquisition of the land identified in Directors Deed DD16450-01-01, this land will be used for public purposes, such as emergency shelter for people experiencing homelessness, public park, projects, and/or public safety facility(ies).
